When the subject of the entry of the United States into the World Court comes up before Congress for discussion and decision on December 17, Mrs. Jas. W. Morrison of Chicago, president of the Illinois League of Women Voters, will broadcast a talk on that subject. She will be representing the Federated Woman's clubs. Winnetka members of the League of Women Voters are being urged to tune in on WMAQ at 4 o'clock that afternoon, which is the hour set for Mrs. Morrison's talk. Mrs. Morrison is a sister of Mrs. Dudley Cates of Winnetka.

Winnetka league members are also urged by the League board to write to their Illinois senators, William McKinley and Charles S. Deneen, urging them to work with President Coolidge for the entry of this country into the World Court.
