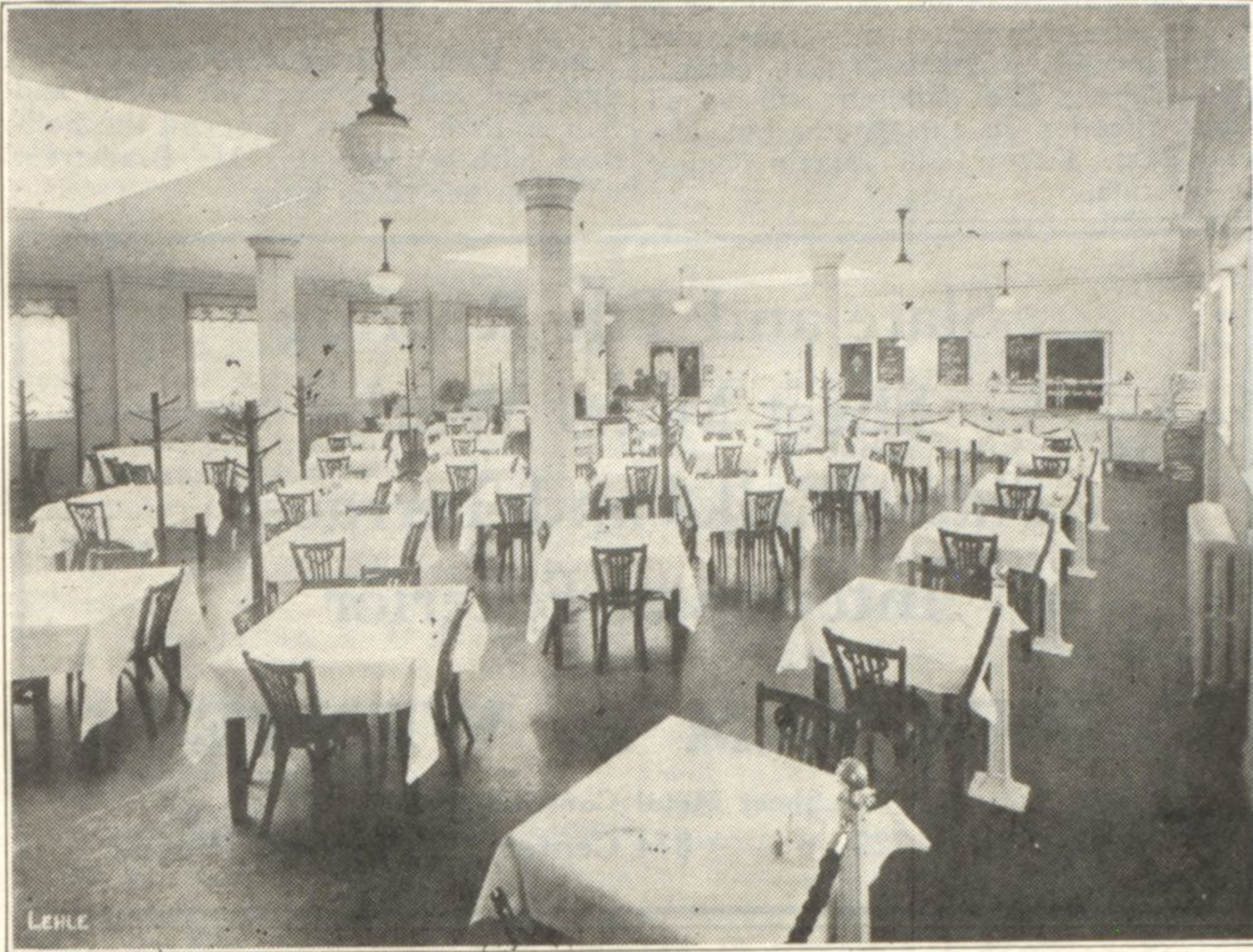


Latest in Eating Places

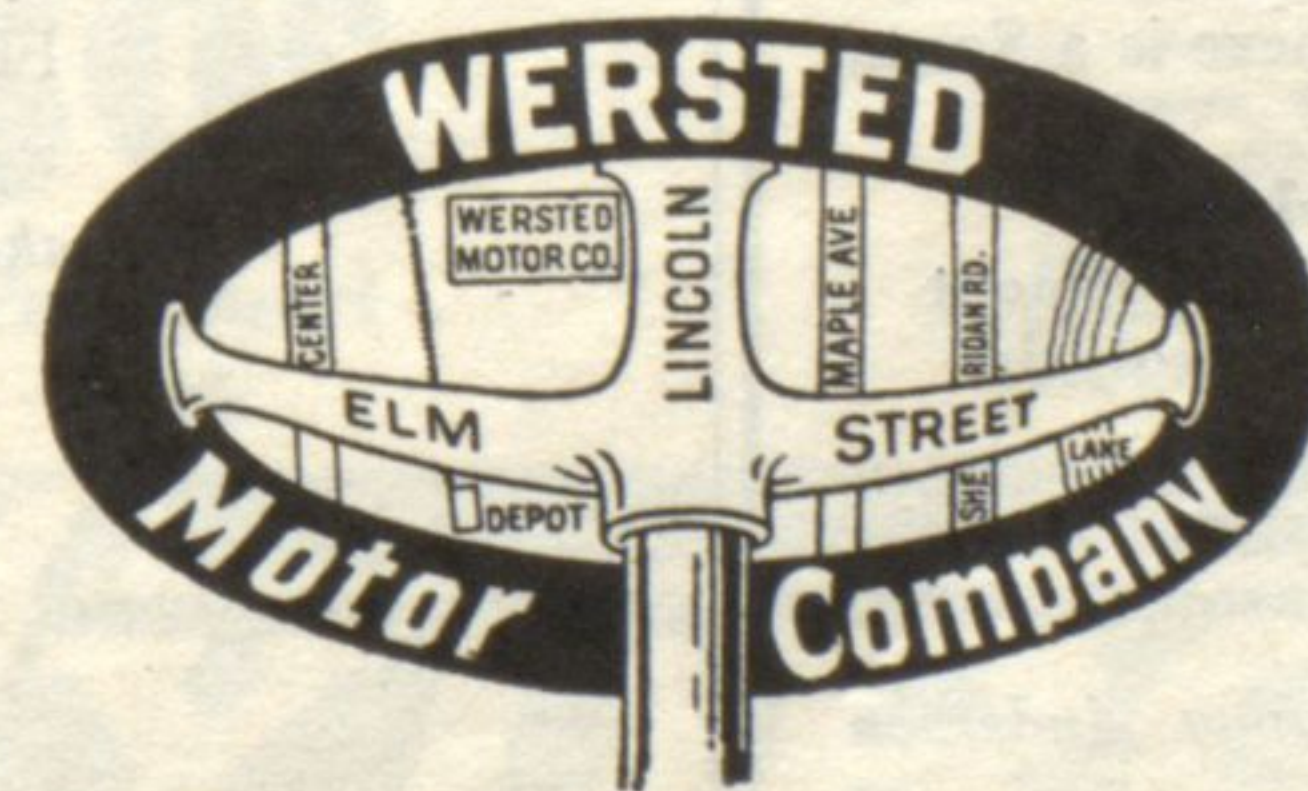
