Wilmette Girl Wins Praise for Her Acting

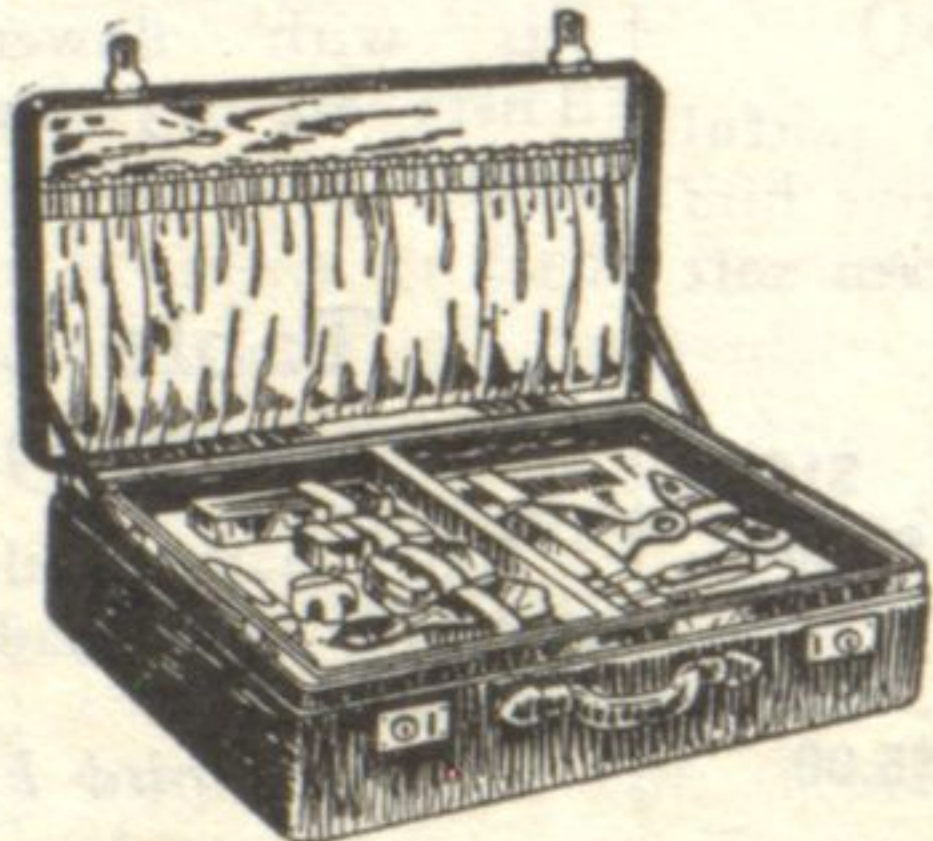
