"RESURRECTION" JAN. 3**

**Mary Garden to Have Leading
Role in American Premiere of
Great Production**

New Year's week—the ninth of the Chicago Civic Opera season—will have as a prelude one of the most interesting offerings of the season Saturday, December 26, in the only performance of the year of "Thais," with Mary Garden in the name role, and at popular prices.

The latter constitutes the outstanding feature of the week, being accentuated at the beginning and end. Sunday, December 27, the first popular priced "Suburban matinee" of the year is expected to draw hosts from near and far to hear the first presentation on that day of "Martha." The cast will include Macbeth, Pavloska, Cortis, Lazzari, Trevistan. Conductor, Moran-zoni.

Monday evening Mary Garden will be heard again in "Carman" with an array of artists including Anseau, Baklanoff; Oukrainsky and Corps de Ballet. Conductor, Grovlez.

Tuesday evening ushers in the picturesque and colorful "Otello"—one of the greatest of operas—with Fritziu, Claessens, Marshall, Bonelli. Conduc-tor, Moran-zoni.

Wednesday evening brings an equal-ly attractive and novel bill "Falstaff" with Raisa, Mason, Pavloska, Cleas-sens, Hackett, Marshall, Rimini, Laz-zari, Steel. Conductor, Polacco.

Give "Resurrection" Thursday

Thursday, New Year's Eve—will give America its first hearing of "Resurrec-tion," an opera by Franco Alfano, based upon the famous novel of that name by Tolstoi. A sensation abroad, it has been reserved as the "high spot" of the season. Mary Garden and a star cast, including Anseau and Bak-lanoff will create the several roles and special prices will be charged. Roberto Moran-zoni will conduct.

Friday evening, the vast auditorium will be dark, to blossom forth again in beauty Saturday afternoon with "Ma-non Lescaut," with Muzio, Cortis, Rim-ini, Cotreuil. Conductor, Moran-zoni.

Saturday evening, devoted to pop-ular prices, will bring "Madame But-terfly" with Edith Mason in the name

role, and Pavloska, Hackett, Rimini. Conductor, Polacco.

Sunday, January 3, introduces an-other treat in the form of a "Suburban matinee" at popular prices—and a dou-ble bill. The musical classic of child-hood, "Hansel and Gretel" will be sung, in English, by a cast including Shear, Pavloska, Lenska, Preston. Conductor, St. Leger, and will be followed by "La Fete a Robinson, produced by the Pav-ley-Oukrainsky Ballet, with Gabriel Grovlez as conductor.

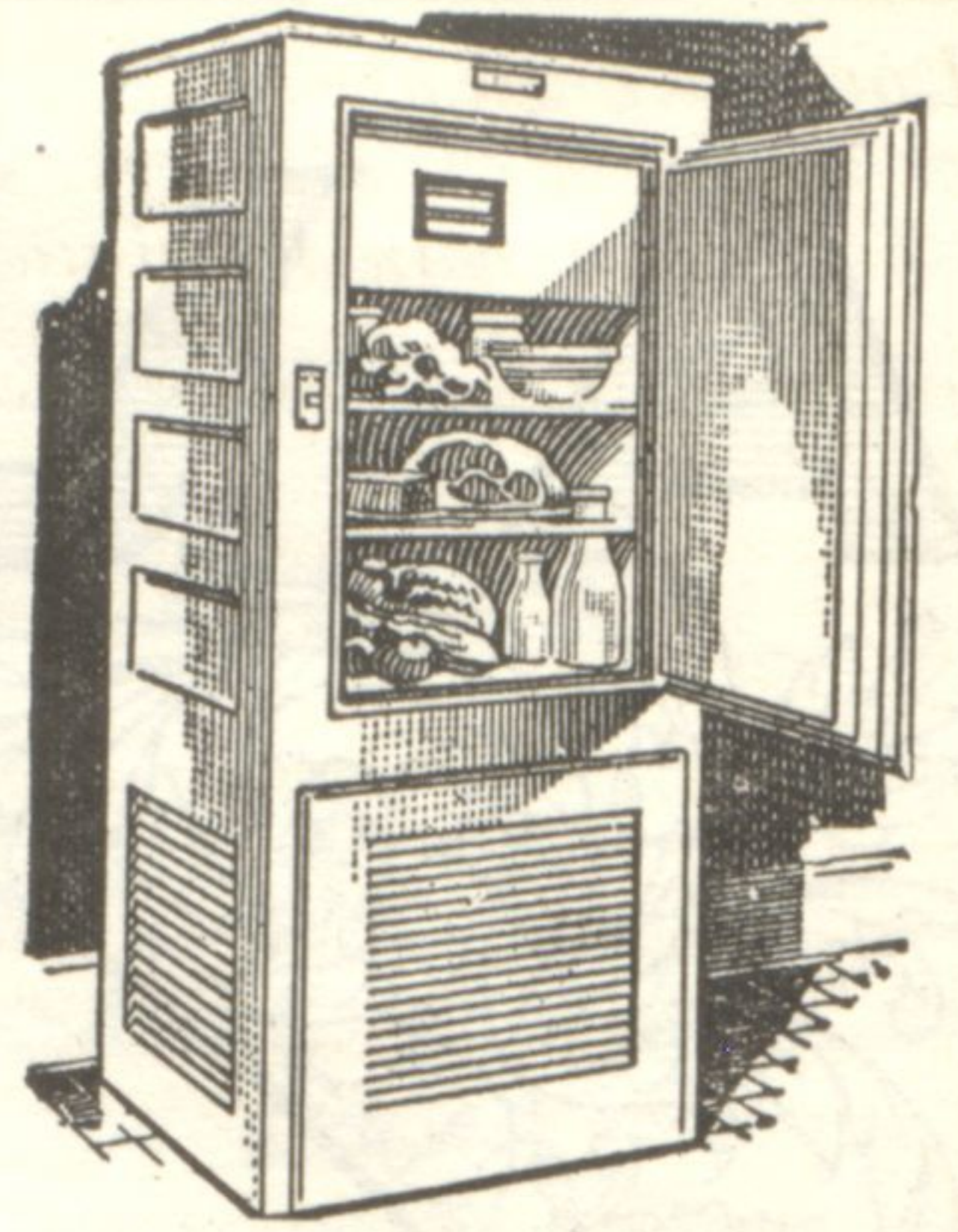
Analyzed by performance, or taken in its entirety, the week is one of the most ambitious and intriguing in this history of the Chicago Civic Opera company.
