## Race Problems Will Be Chicago Forum Subject

The Chicago Forum will challenge the thought of the community on the problem of race relations at its meeting in the Apollo theatre Sunday afternoon, January 3, Fred A. Moore, the director, has announced. The speaker will be Dr. M. Ashby Jones of Atlanta, president of the Inter-Race Relations Commission which is doing the biggest piece of constructive work on the problem of race relations in the South that has been undertaken since the Civil war. Dr. Jones is the minister of one of the largest churches in the South and is therefore a reliable exponent of the progressive public opinion in the South on what has been a seemingly insoluble social problem. Dr. Jones' subject will be "The Race Problem from a Southern Stand Point." The usual question period will follow the address. Music will be provided by a negro male quartet from the Metropolitan Glee club.

## Milan Lusk Gains Big Following of Radio Listeners

Recently Milan Lusk, the distinguished violinist, appeared on a special radio program and achieved a noteworthy success.
