This club gradually became larger, and when Sir George became the head of the firm, he established it in rooms of its own. Before long other influential men became interested, and in 1844 the Y. M. C. A. was founded. It has since spread all over the world but its main aims remain the same as those given it by the founder.

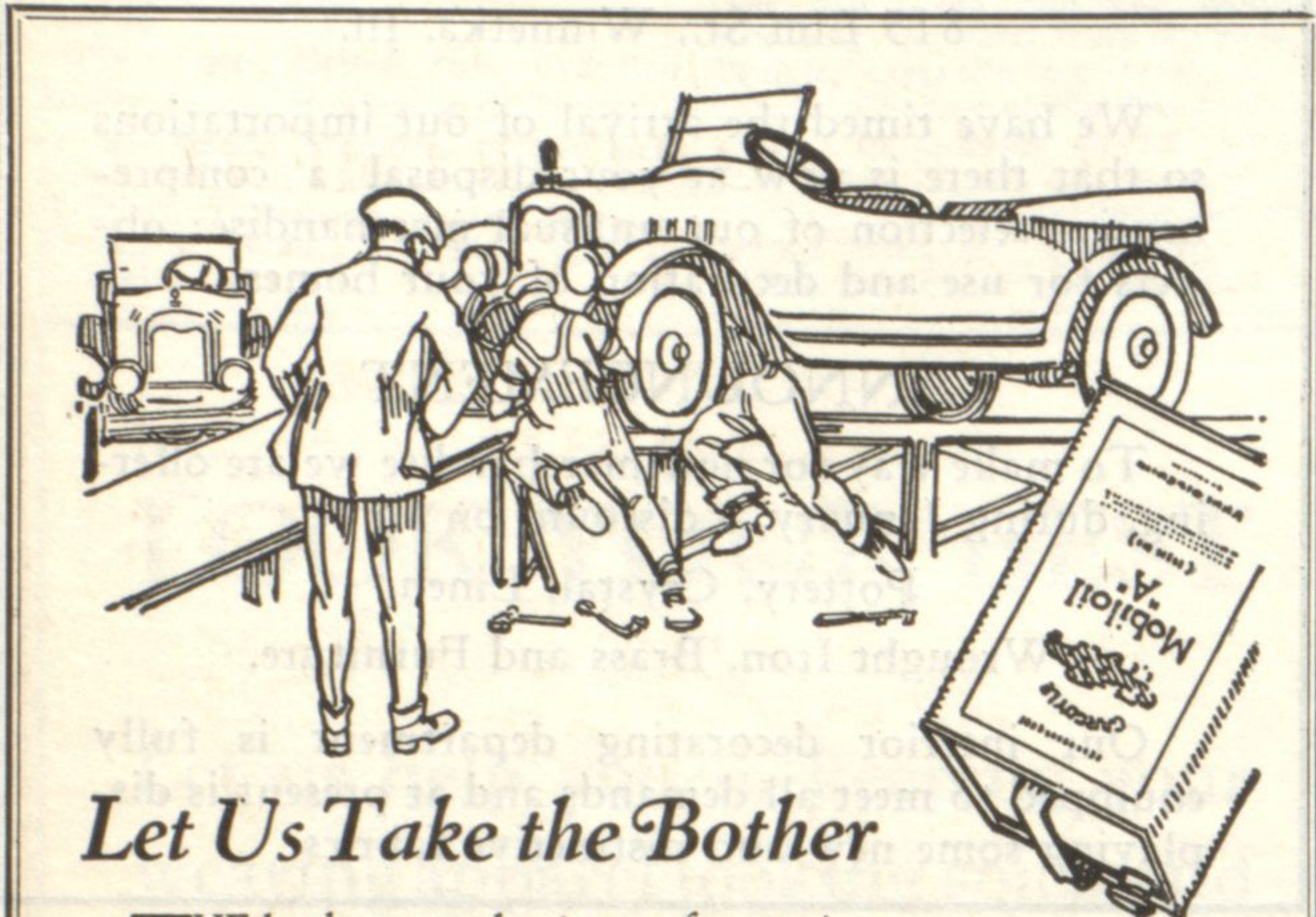
The program for the next two weeks is as follows:—

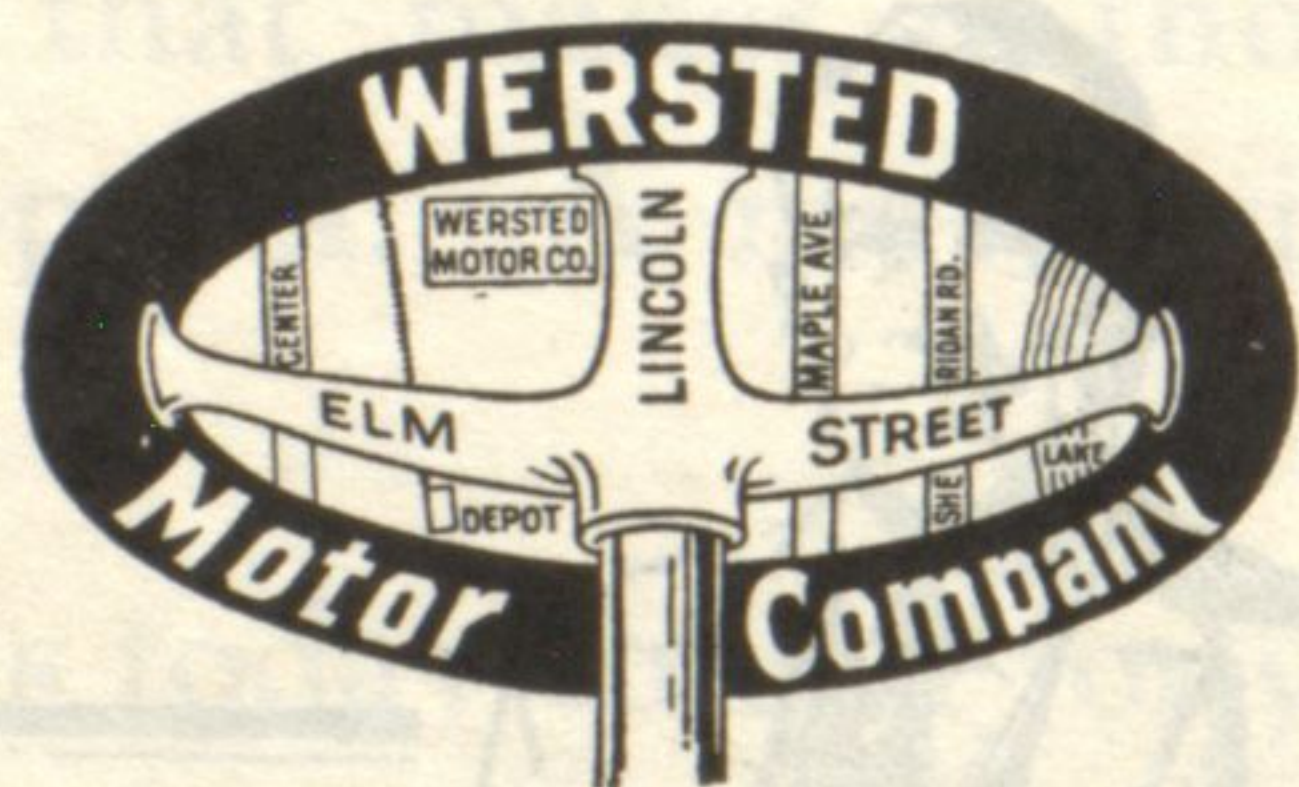

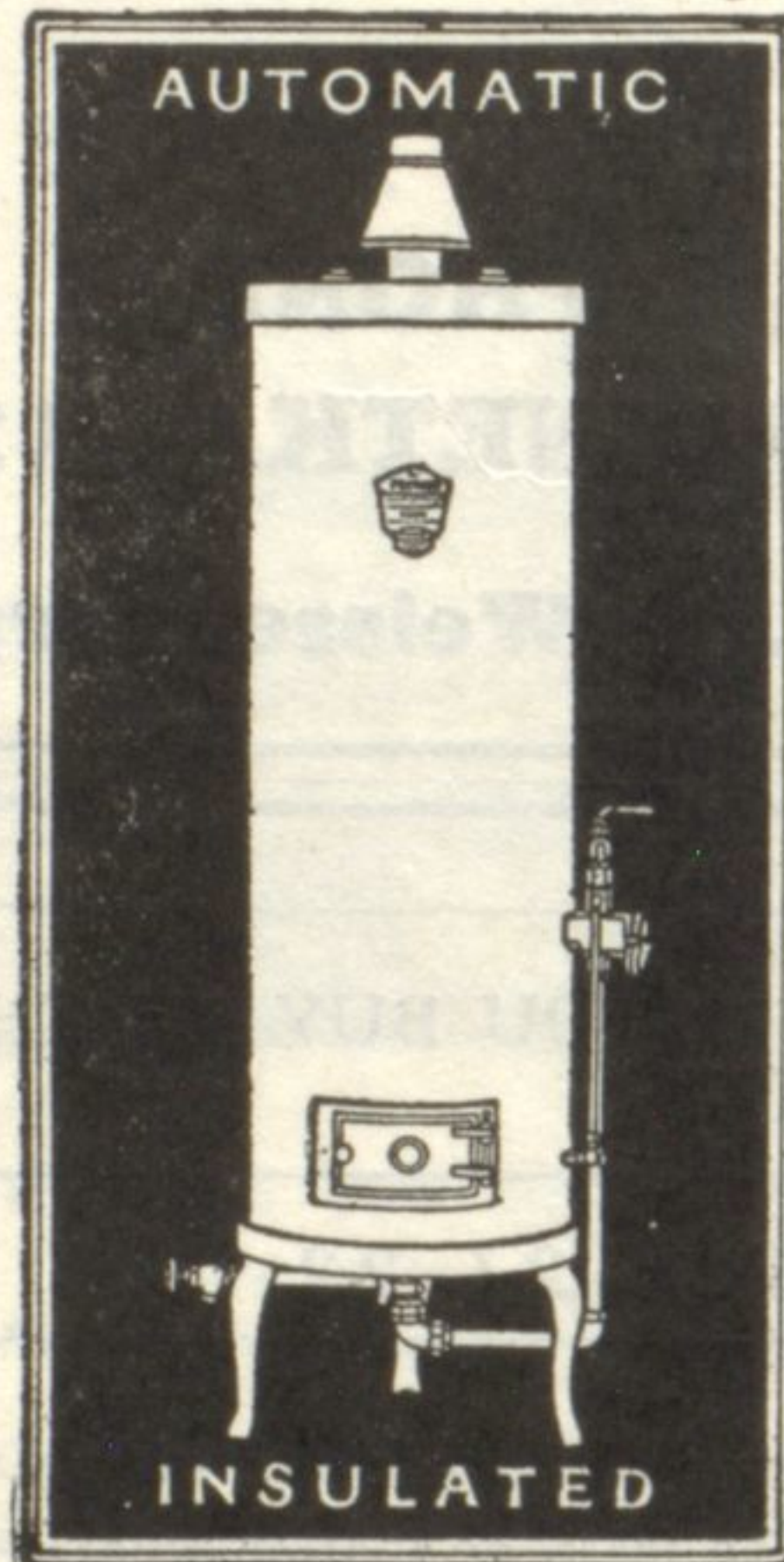
