Noted Lecturer Gives Clever Talk on "Seven Kinds of Marriage" as Booth House Benefit

After postponing the lecture a week in deference to a lecture given by Dr. Harold Rugg under the auspices of the Parent-Teacher association, Horace Bridges gave his dignified, clever, and interesting talk on "The Seven Kinds of Marriage" at the Winnetka Woman's club before an audience of about 300 persons, Tuesday evening, March 9. Nearly 400 tickets were sold for the lecture which was given for the benefit of the kindergarten of the Henry Booth House. As Mr. Bridges, who is president of Booth House, gave his talk without charge, and as the expenses of the hall were donated, the entire proceeds will be given to the kindergarten, which, because of the success of the venture, can be kept open throughout the summer months.
