Next Club Meeting to Feature Program Devoted to Mexico

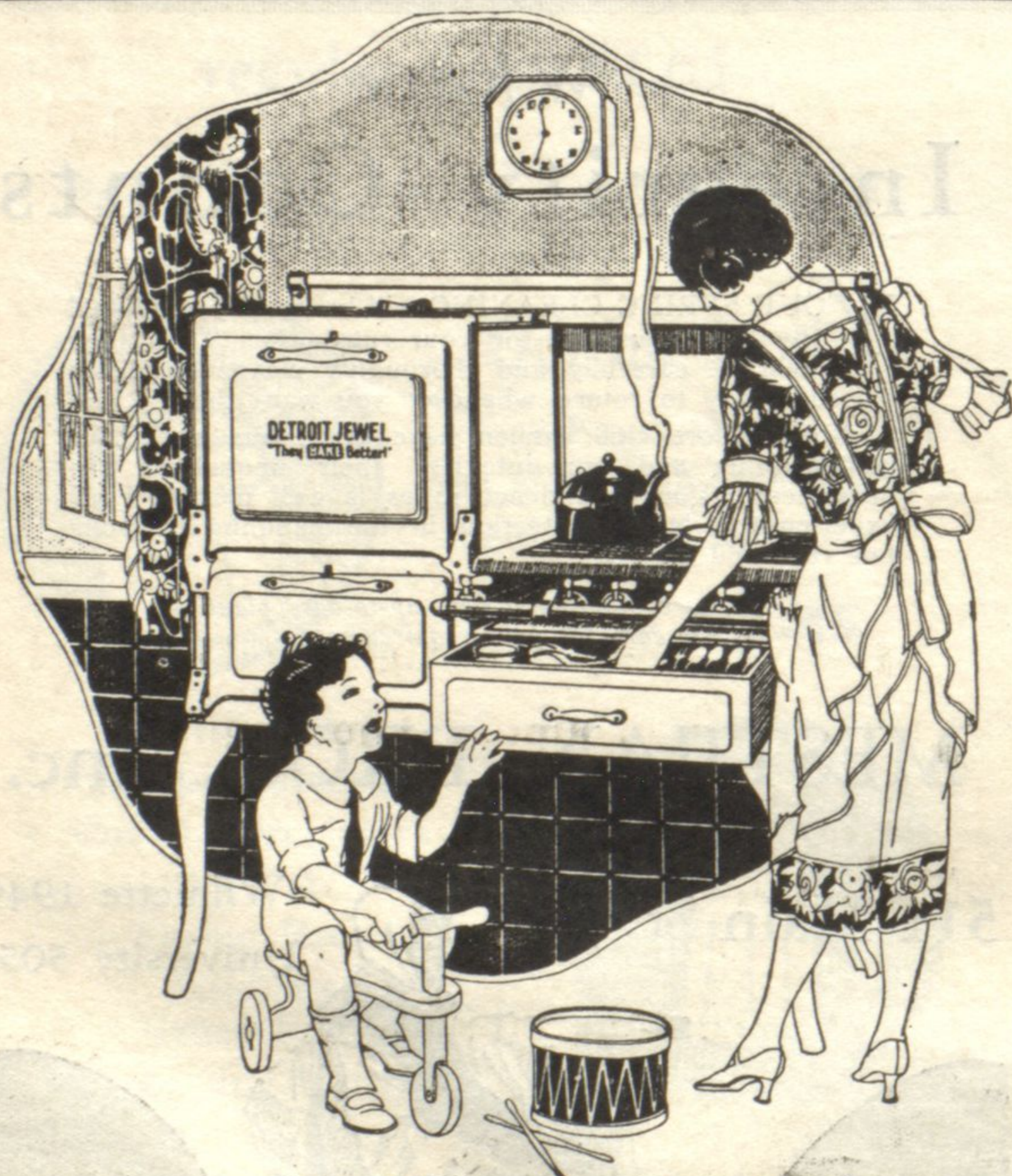
