### Locust Inn Raiders Taken at Winnetka

Acting on a "tip" from Albert Ottone, a former Winnetka policeman, Chief of Police W. M. Peterson of Winnetka last week arrested three men who had stolen furnishings valued at more than \$1,000 from the Locust Inn, a roadhouse on the outskirts of Wilmette.

The men are Anton Angier, of Morton Grove, Rocco Delcastro, 1629 West Huron street, Chicago, and Ralph Brajd, of 1456 West Eighteenth street, Chicago. The men were captured after they had taken part in another burglary near Winnetka. Chief Peterson arrested them when they attempted to dispose of some stolen goods in the village.

The trio was turned over to the County highway police, and are now awaiting trial on charges of burglary. They told the police that they had intended to return for an electric piano, which they found at the Locust Inn. The roadhouse is closed during the winter.
