North Shore Golfer to Play in Contest at National Exhibit

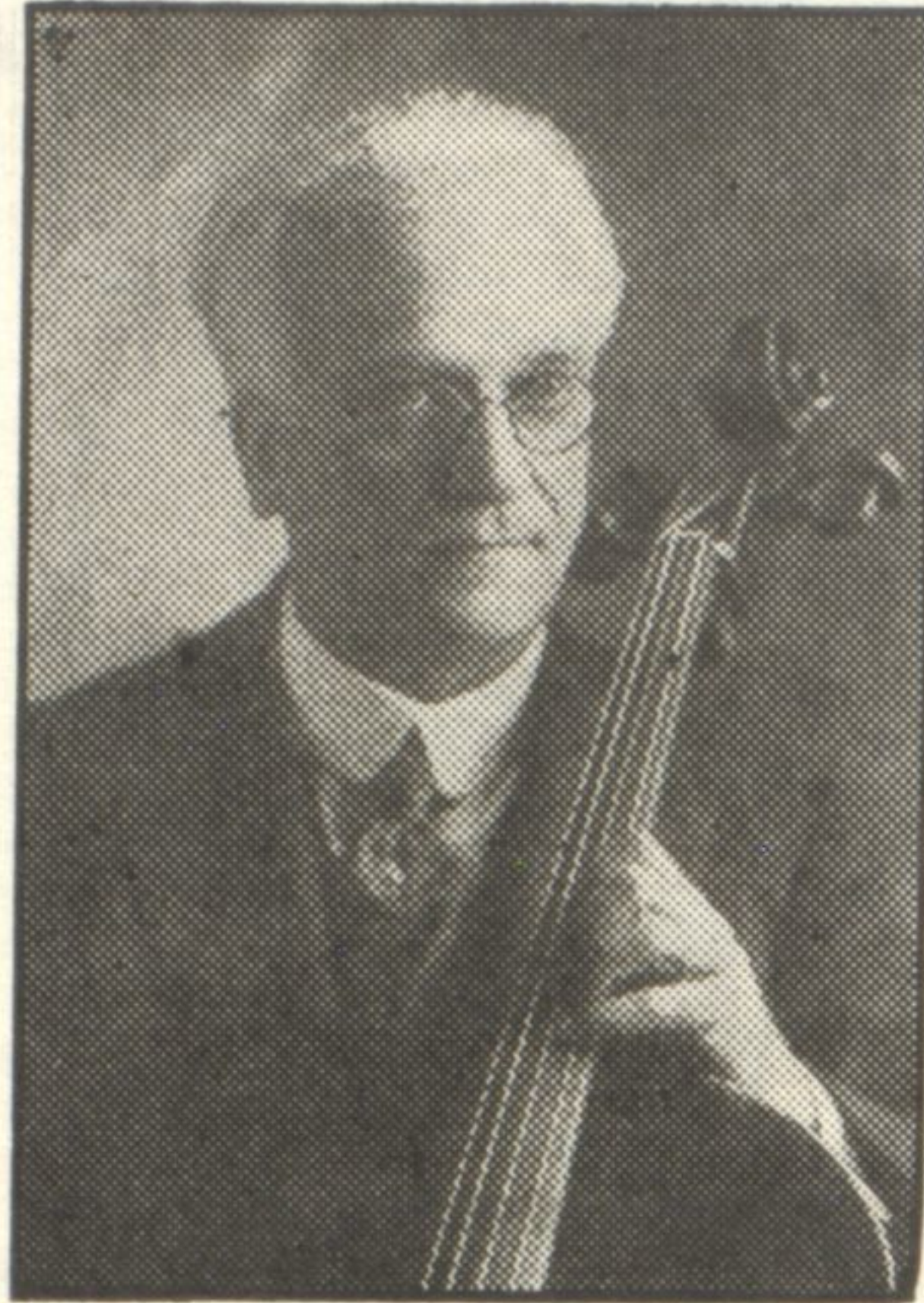

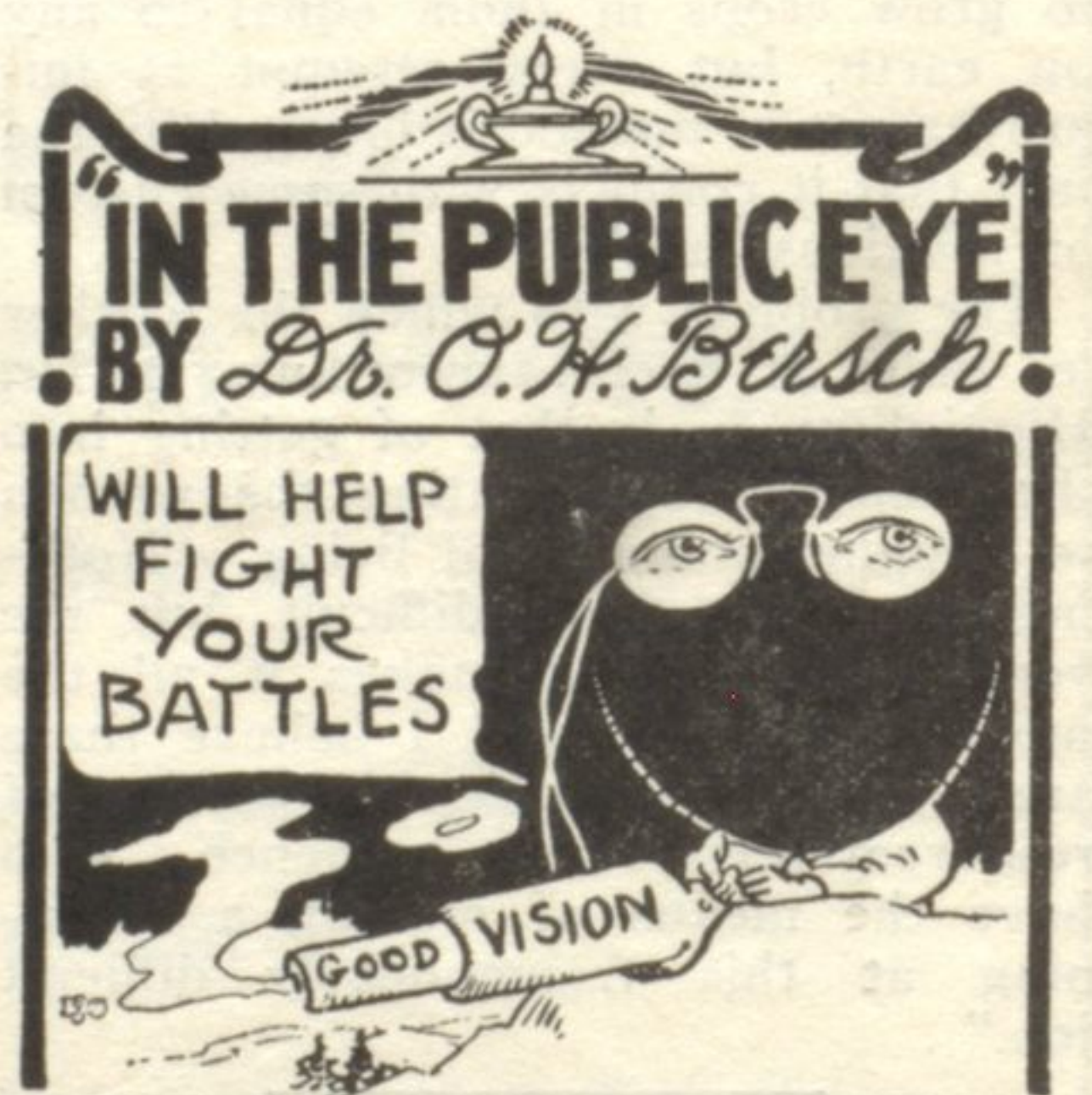
