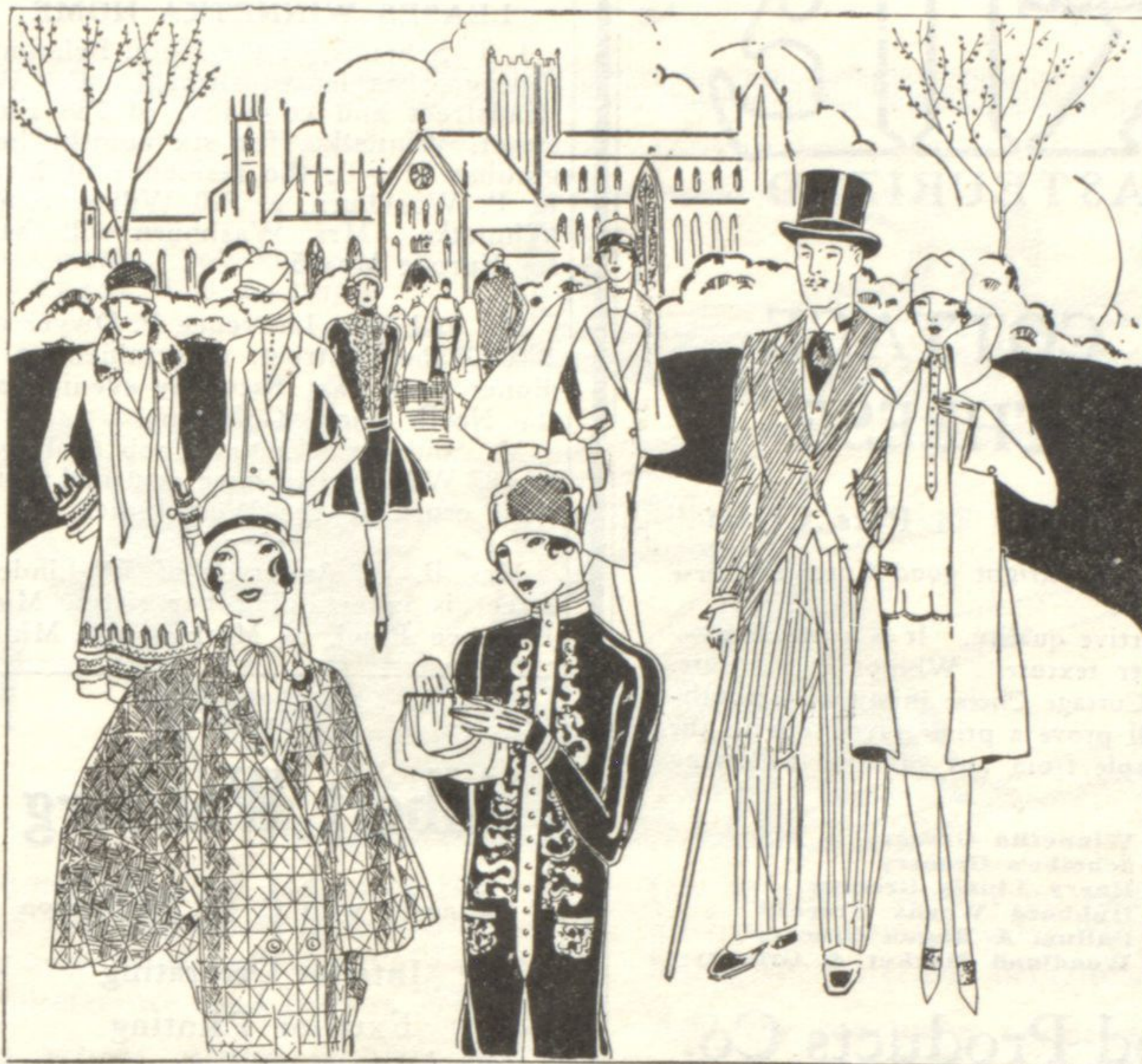


Bangkok The Spring Hat

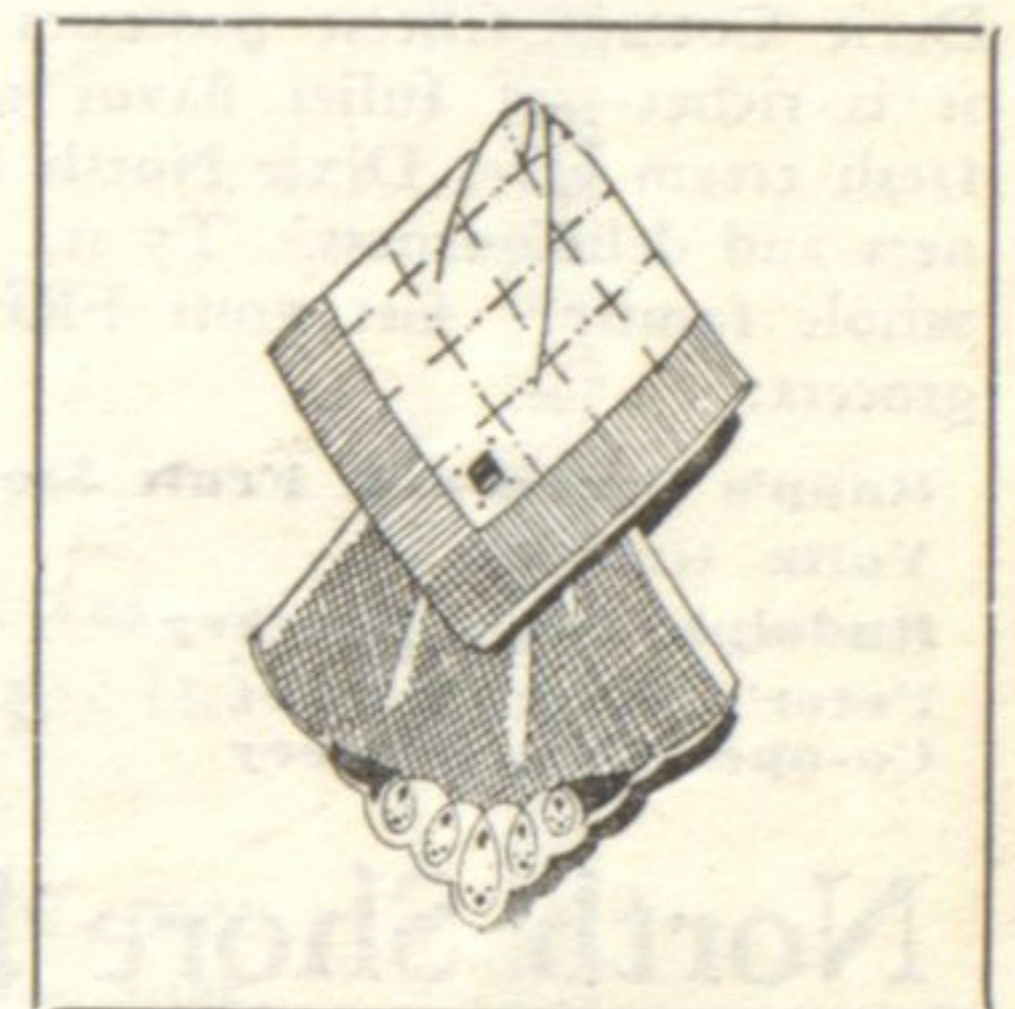

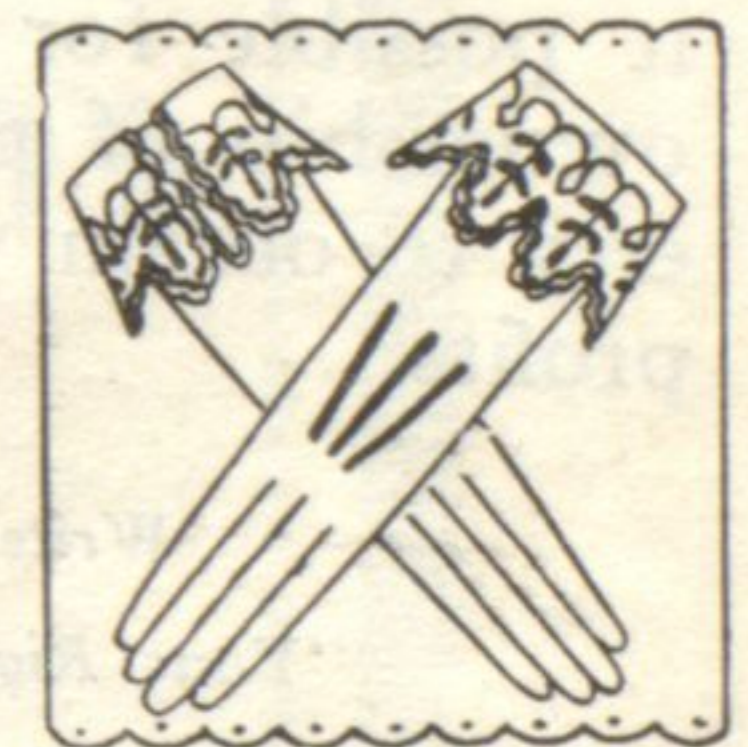
