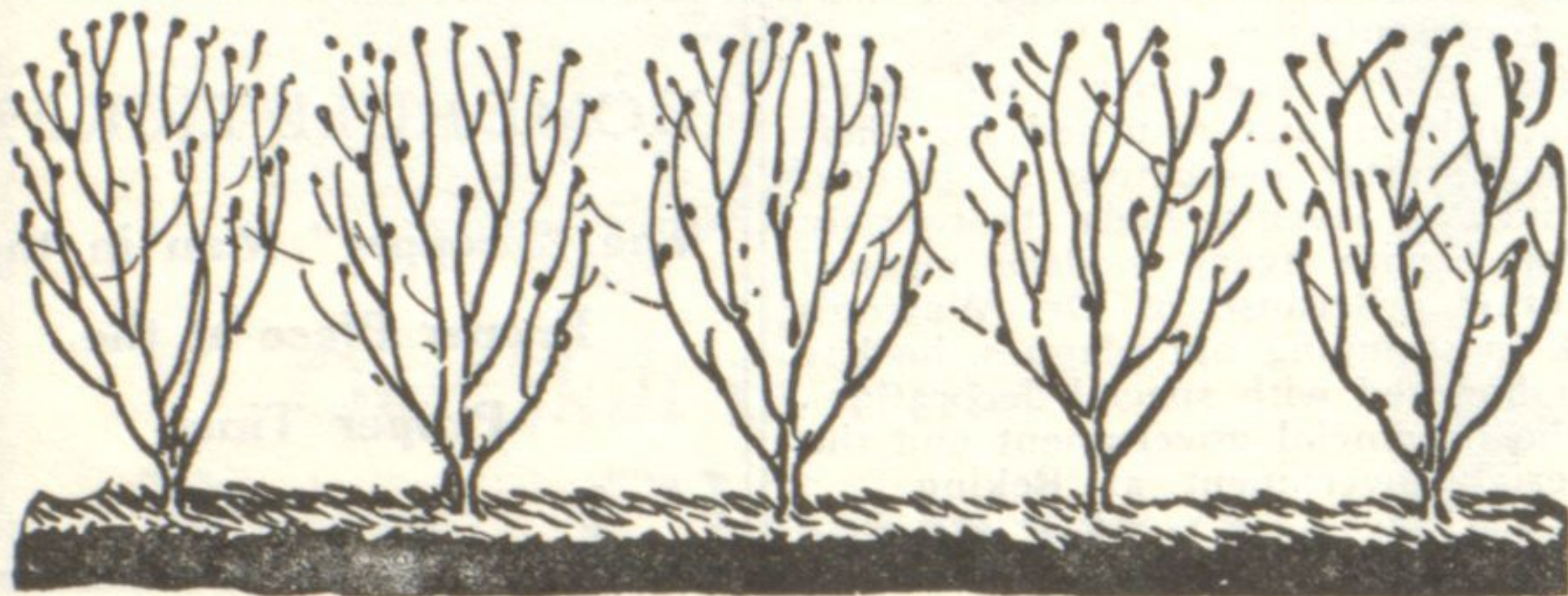

Hoover Lauds Voting Award in New Trier

Herbert Hoover, secretary of Commerce, as far distant as Washington, D. C., has heard of the action of the Winnetka chapter of the Izaak Walton League of America, in posting a fine American flag as an award to be contested for by the four villages of New Trier township, Wilmette, Kenilworth, Winnetka and Glencoe, in the matter of getting out as nearly a 100 percent vote, as possible at Primary election time, and in a telegram to A. M. Ferry, secretary of the Winnetka chapter, compliments that organization most highly for its action in this regard. The telegram received Wednesday, reads:

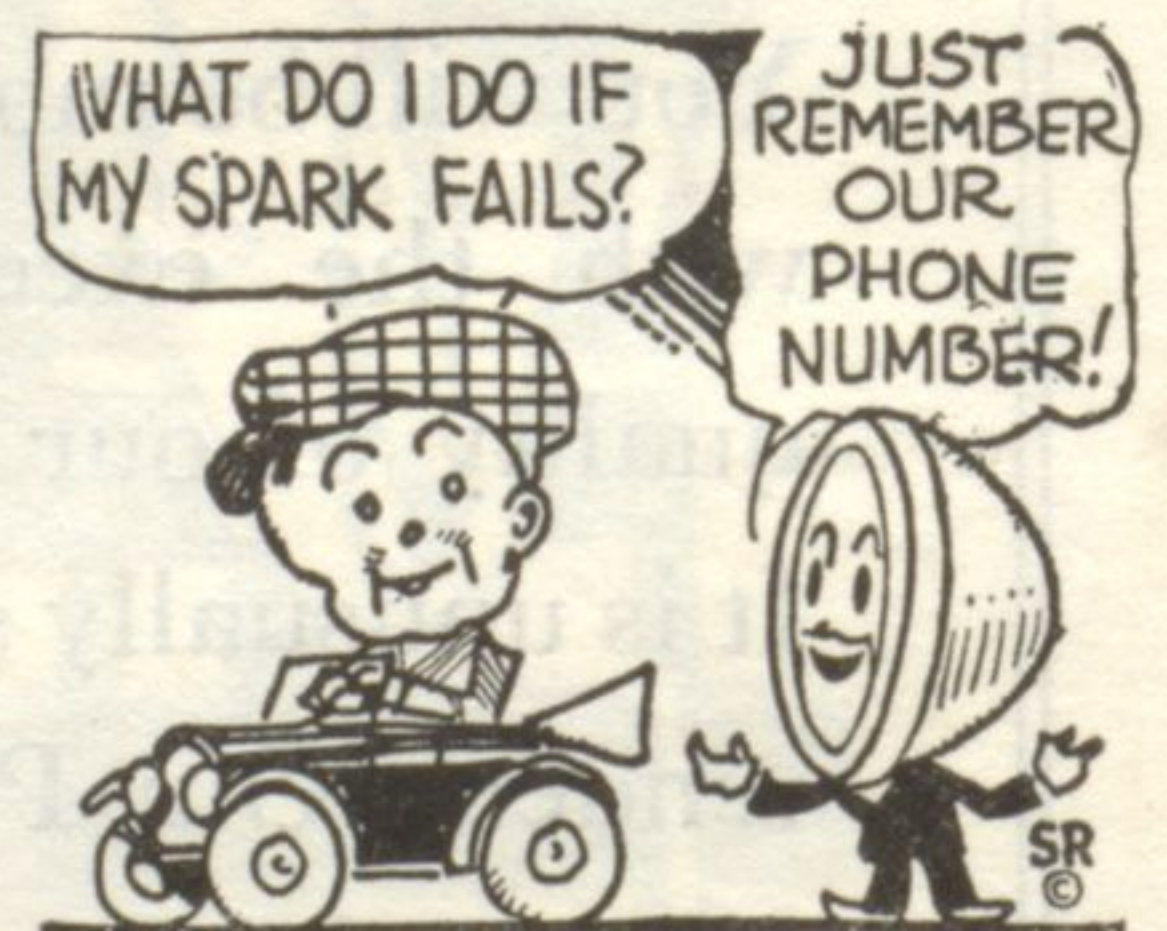
