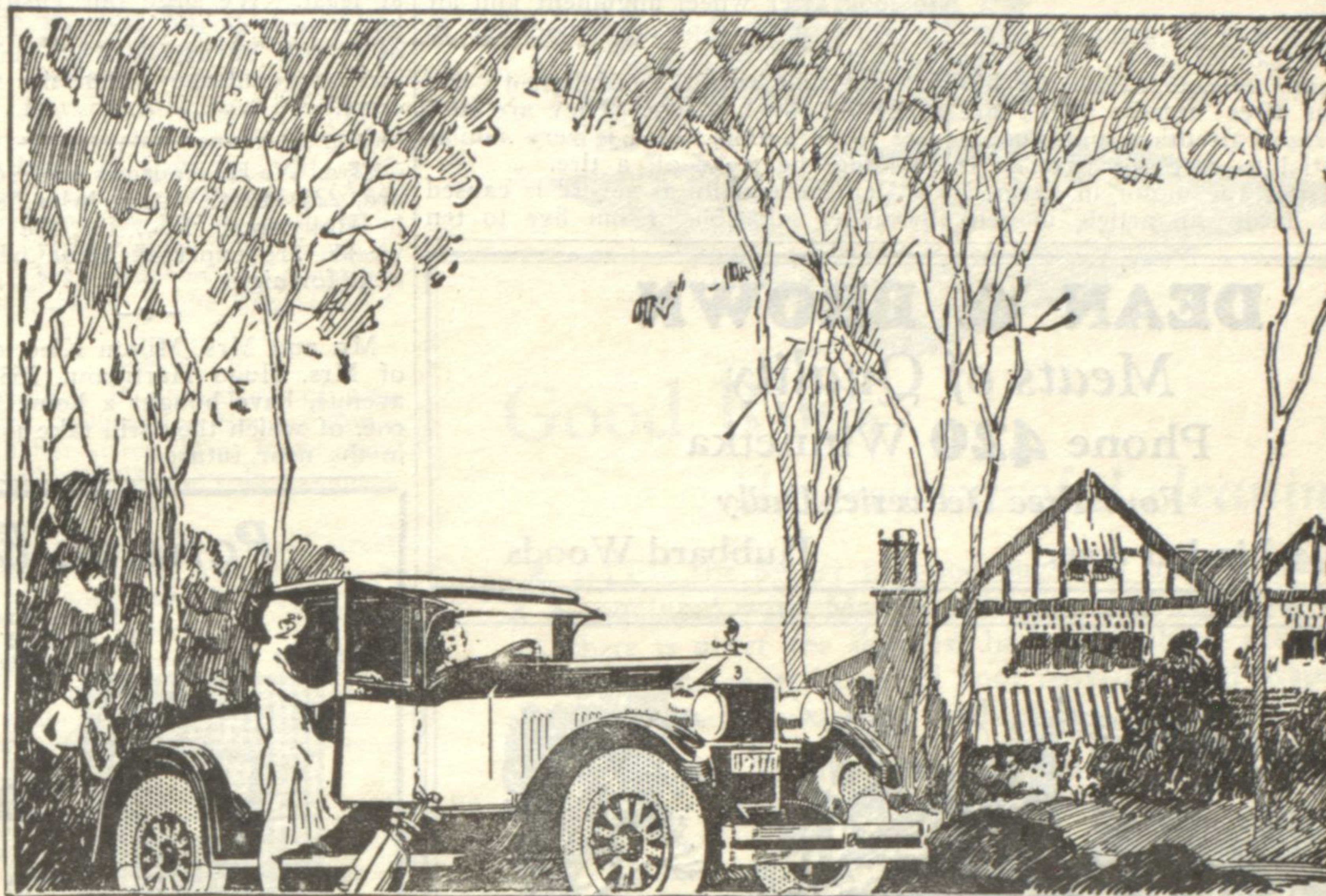
**Camp Fire Sparks**
