Observe Bundle Days on May 5, in All Suburbs

Extensive preparations are being made for the observance of the annual Bundle Day for the Near East Relief on Wednesday, May 5, by all of the schools in Chicago, its suburbs, and in Illinois.

Supt. William McAndrew of Chicago said:

"'Bundle Day' does not involve any special school exercise. All that is involved on the part of the schools is the distribution of literature and an announcement concerning the location of the bundle station to which the children may carry their bundles on the way to school. It is a gathering of unused, cast-off clothing. It is in a sense a relief and convenience to the households which participate. It is really an exercise in thrift, in that it puts to valuable use articles which would otherwise be thrown away. But when there is added to this consideration the fact that these otherwise useless articles are, by patriotic citizens, sent to children suffering the most abject want and deprivation, the movement acquires a spirit of aid and philanthropy which, I am sure, will appeal as heartily to you as it has to all principals, teachers and children who co-operate."

A bundle station will be located near each public school, and if those desiring to contribute their cast-off clothing cannot locate bundle stations, they are urgently requested to send their bundles by parcel post or express to Near East Relief, % Western Warehousing company, 323 W. Polk street, Chicago.
