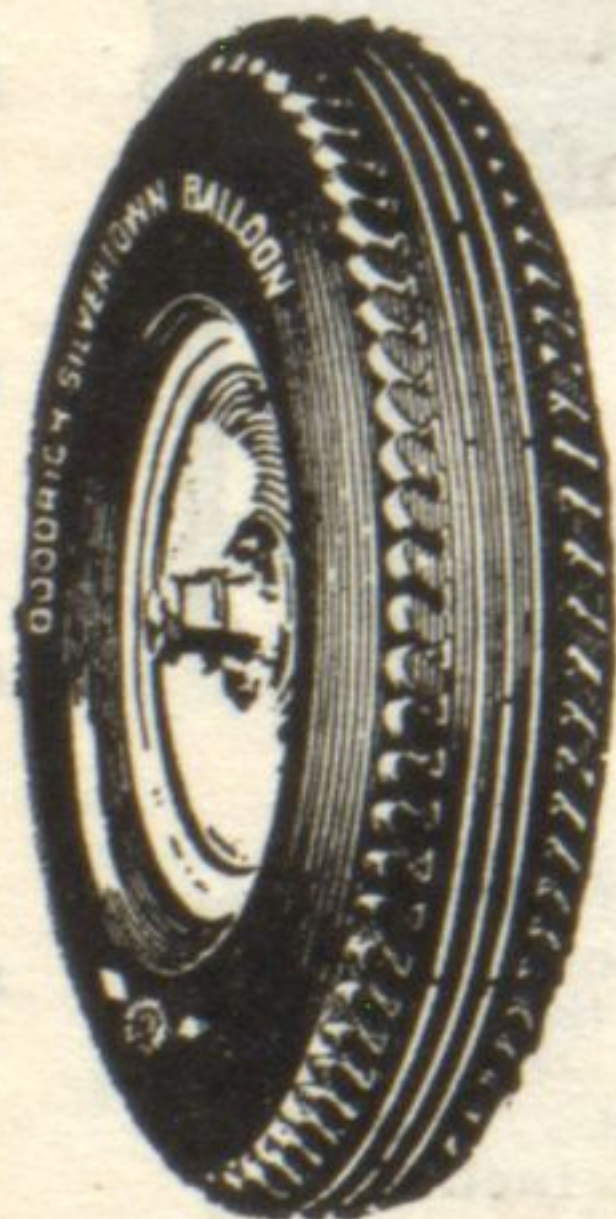

Brilliant Recital Program

Articles appearing in recent issues of WINNETKA TALK have heralded the artists who are to appear on the 1926-27 program of the Winnetka Music club artist-recital series. On this and the succeeding page are shown four artists who will be seen at the New Trier auditorium next season; also a group of singers, the English Ensemble, which has been secured to give one of its unique and highly artistic presentations on one of the evenings.



English Ensemble

The English Singers were brought to this country by Mrs. F. S. Coolidge to take part in her Library of Congress festival in Washington last spring. Their concerts are described as of the best from the standpoint of musical material, technical finish, and interpretive excellence.

Tito Schipa, tenor of the Chicago Civic Opera company, is well known to all north shore music lovers. He is one of the prime favorites at Ravinia and among the most beloved artists in the country.

Cecilia Hansen, violinist, has gained the heights of popularity in four short seasons. She is spoken of as the greatest woman violinist of the day. She has played with all the great orchestras including the Chicago Symphony.

Guimar Novaes, pianist, is looking forward to her tenth season in the United States. A native of Brazil, she has been termed the "Paderewski of the Pampas," and is regarded by certain critics as the greatest woman pianist of the day. She is said never to have given a routine performance.

Maria Kurenko, Russian soprano, is hailed by many critics as the "new star in the musical firmament." She is both an opera singer and a lawyer.

The marvel of her voice has long been known abroad and her reputation in this country places her in the fore-ranks of the musical field.

It is only two years since the Winnetka Music club artist-recital series had its beginning. Already it is most favorably and widely known. The artists are invariably selected from those of the first rank. The following have been presented: Louise Homer, Ossip Gabrilowitsch, Reinald Werrenrath, Pablo Casals, Maria Ivogun, Margaret Matzenauer, Alexander Brailowsky, Dusolina Giannini, Albert Spalding and Edward Johnson. The names of the artists announced in this article for the coming season, likewise speak for themselves.
