

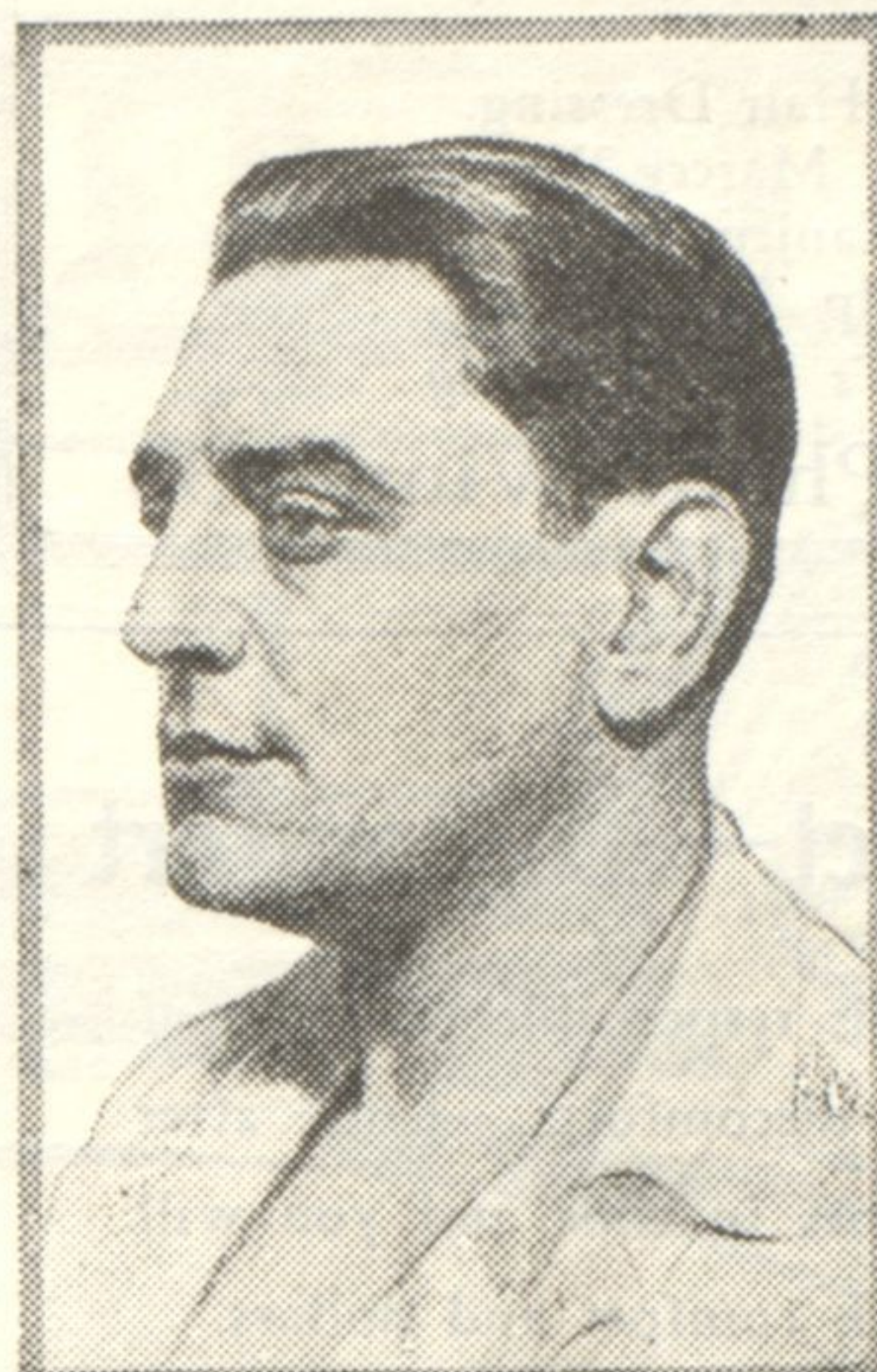
Music Club Secures Galaxy of Stars for 1926-27 Season

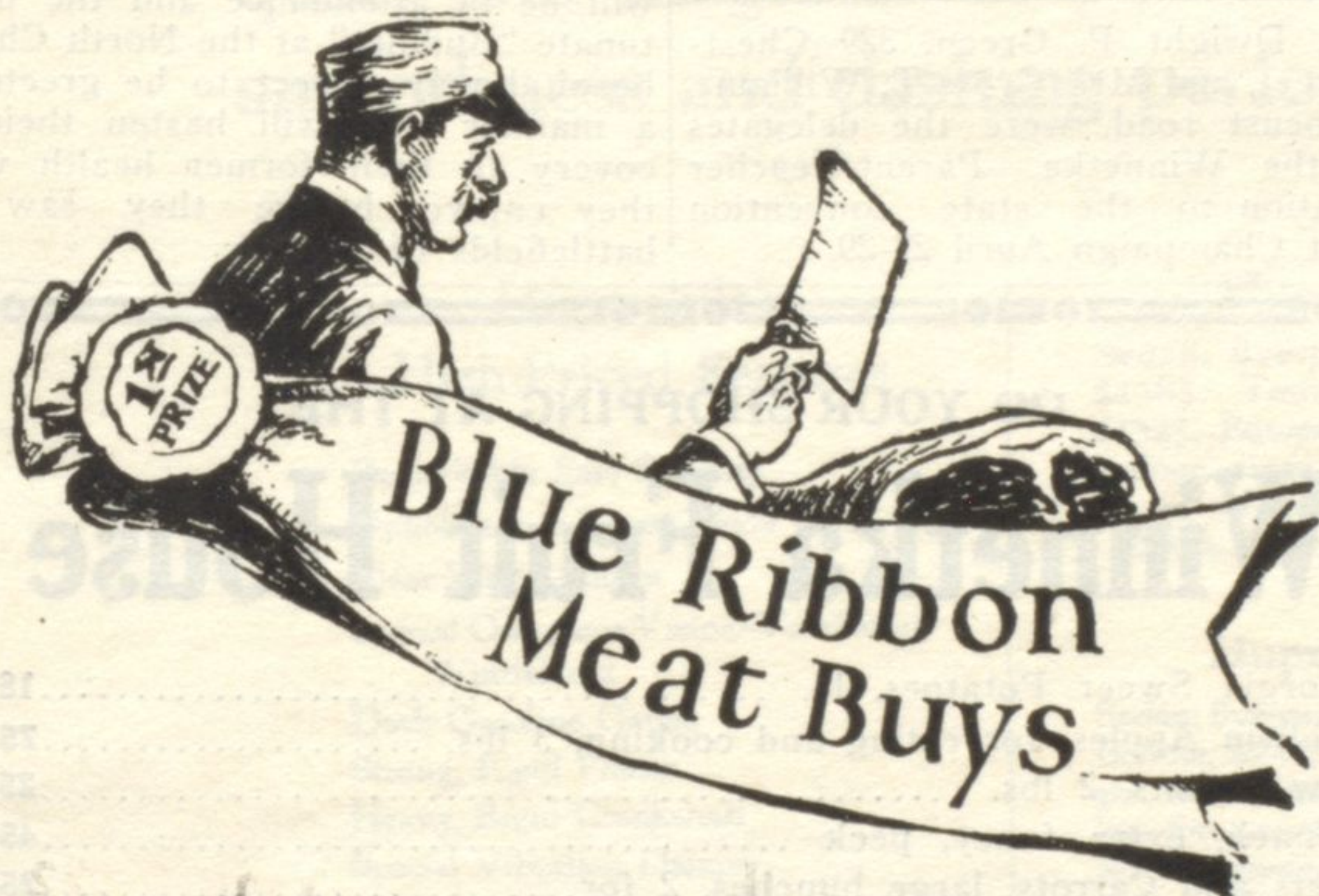
