### American Opera Creates Sensation in Cincinnati

Howard Preston, well-known opera singer of 1032 Greenwood avenue, Wilmette, has just returned from Cincinnati where he created a sensation in singing the leading role in Ralph Syford's new American opera "Castle Agranant," April 29-30.

A capacity audience of more than 7,000 people occupied the huge music hall, which included musical critics and representatives from all over the United States, and one heard only unqualified praise on every side, it was said.

At the close of the second act the composer and singers received an ovation lasting almost half an hour. The daily press and the critics were said to have been unanimous in pronouncing the opera a big success and Mr. Preston's role an astounding achievement, both from vocal as well as a dramatic standpoint.

### LET WATER MAIN CONTRACT

At the meeting of the Kenilworth Board of Local Improvements, held Tuesday evening of this week, the contract for the construction of water mains and of extensions and improvements to the existing system was awarded to the Highways Construction company. The amount of the contract is \$40,555.30. Work on the improvement will begin in the near future, it was said.

### APPROVE CURRENT CONTRACT

The Kenilworth Board of Local Improvements, at its meeting held Tuesday evening of this week, approved a contract with the Public Service Company of Northern Illinois, for electric current for the new street lighting system. The system is now under construction and is expected to be completed about July 30. It is thought that the contract, as approved by the Board, will be entered into at a later meeting.

### VALLEY RATES LOWER

#### Commutation Fares on New Route of North Shore Line Revised Materially Downward

Announcement of commutation rates applicable to the new Skokie Valley route of the North Shore line has been made, effective June 1.

Substantial downward revision is made on 60-ride bearer tickets which apply to all points on the line in Illinois, while the 10-ride and 25-ride tickets remain at the old rate.

The Skokie Valley line is expected to open to general traffic on June 5, and the new commutation tickets will be on sale at the various stations of the company after May 25.

Under the revised rates a 60-ride individual ticket to Libertyville will be \$15.72, as compared with \$33.75, the present rate, while the 25-ride ticket is \$15 and the 10-ride \$6.94. The rate to Mundelein for the 60-ride ticket will be \$17 while the present rate is \$36.45.

#### Rates Correspond

Rates to the nine new stations on the Skokie Valley route correspond with the present rates on the Shore line route. The rate for instance to Northbrook on the new line is the same as the rate to Glencoe on the present line and the rate to Sheridan Elms on the Skokie is the same as the present rate to Fort Sheridan on the Shore line.

Commuters using the 60-ride ticket from points near the Wisconsin state line will benefit materially from the revision in rates. The present 60-ride ticket to Zion is \$39.60 while the new rate is \$18.02. The present Waukegan rate is \$33.75 and the new rate \$16.70.

The rates quoted are from the Loop stations including Roosevelt road on the south side and Grand avenue on the north side. Correspondingly lower rates apply at Wilson avenue and Howard street on the north side.

No change has been made in single fares which remain at the established rate of 3 cents a mile.
