

One of them, by the way, is the storm sewer catch basins. They have to be oiled every ten days throughout the summer in order to keep mosquitoes from breeding within.

"Then Major Skinner checks up with the men to see that the work is done, properly. Householders can help by making sure that they are not breeding mosquitoes on their own premises. A survey of 3,000 houses on the west side and in Glencoe, last year,

revealed that 42 per cent were breeding mosquitoes. They breed in stopped-up roof gutters, in tin cans, in the back yards, which hold a few teaspoons full of water and in cesspools where they are used.

"In making these 3,000 inspections, Boy Scouts were invaluable. Out in Oak Park, Berwyn, La Grange and Downers Grove they quickly learned where to look for breeding and became adept in pointing out actual wiggletails to the home-owners. They are at work again this year.


