"We get all set over here and wait for some landlubber to come along and get into trouble," said Captain Fricke, who has helped pull many an Evans-tonian out of the water and has assisted numerous broken down motor boats and sailing crafts back to harbor.

"The station has a complete complement of men this year. We have eight good men and true who will be always on the lookout for mishaps. We have already started our outdoor drills and the boys are leaning to with a hearty good will."

The big steamers and freighters are beginning to run now, according to the captain. Every hour sees some big boat pull out of Chicago harbor and labor up the lake.
