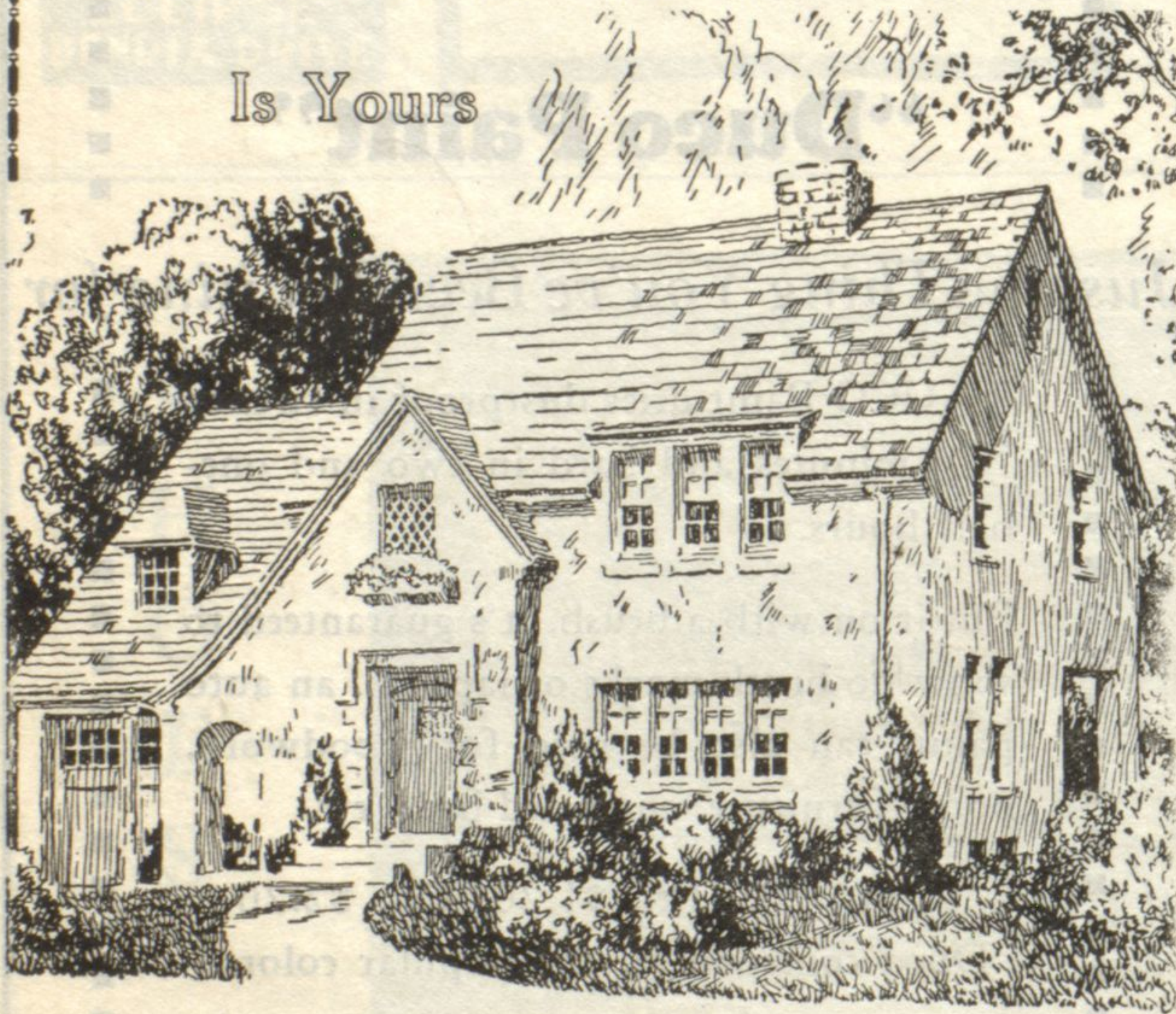
AT INDIAN HILL CLUB
