Here Comes the Bride

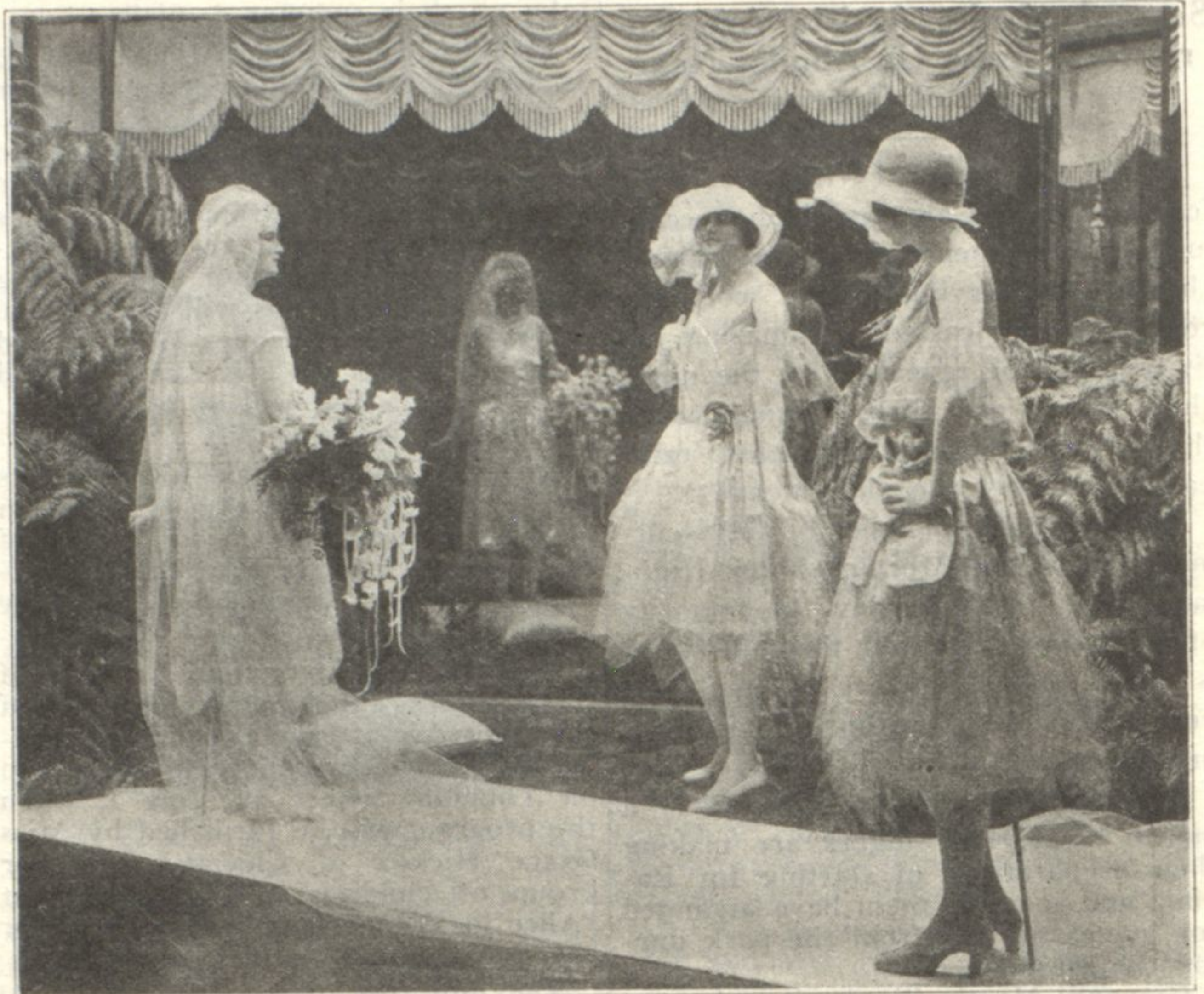
