Plan Open Dormitory in Women's Quadrangle

A new open dormitory for women has been assured to the women students at Northwestern university, according to an announcement by President Walter Dill Scott. It will be a double dormitory to accommodate sixty girls and will be located on the new campus for women in Evanston. This dormitory will be open to all women students without regard to their membership or non-membership in a sorority. It will be one of the largest dormitorial buildings for women on the entire campus. The cost will be \$200,000 of which \$100,000 has been pledged. The balance of the cost will be bonded and paid off over a term of years unless a generous donor should desire the building named after him or her, when the arrangements would be made.

"This new open double dormitory for women is in keeping with the general program of housing our women students on our own campus," said President Scott. "It will be built of Bedford stone and will harmonize with the fourteen new sorority buildings, ground-breaking for which is scheduled for June 12th."

Mrs. Carl R. Latham, a member of the board of trustees, who is an alumna of Northwestern university, and a former resident of Wilmette, was complimented by Dr. Scott for her unceasing efforts to bring about an open dormitory. Various sister alumnae and several Evanston organizations that have loyally worked for years to reach the consummation, also were paid warm tribute.

Christian Science

"Ancient and Modern Necromancy, Alias Mesmerism and Hypnotism, Denounced" was the subject of the Lesson-Sermon in all Churches of Christ, Scientist, Sunday, May 30.

The Golden Text was from I Peter 3:12, "The eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers; but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil."

Among the citations which comprised the Lesson-Sermon was the following from the Bible: "Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Stand therefore, having your lions girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked" (Ephesians 6:11, 12, 14, 16).

The Lesson-Sermon also included the following passage from the Christian Science textbook, "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures," by Mary Baker Eddy: "Erring human mind-forces can work only evil under whatever name or pretence they are employed; for Spirit and matter, good and evil, light and darkness, cannot mingle. Evil is a negation, because it is the absence of truth. It is nothing, because it is the absence of something" (p. 186).
