125 Students Receive Diplomas at N. K. E. T. C.

The 40th annual Commencement of the National Kindergarten and Elementary college was held in Harrison hall Wednesday afternoon, June 9, at 3 o'clock, the commencement address being delivered by Horace J. Bridges, leader of the Chicago Ethical society.

President Edna Dean Baker gave a short report of the progress of the college during the year,—a year which stands out in the history of the school in that it has seen the completion of Harrison hall, the removal from Chicago to the north shore and the dedication of the building.

Diplomas were presented to 125 young women who have completed two, three or four year courses offered by the college, and eight honorary scholarships, in recognition of outstanding ability and character, were presented to students, enabling them to return for the third year of training.
