This opera, with its magnificent arias and ensembles is a stand-by of the standard list, and no better cast could be found than the one available at Ravinia. Both Mme. dramatic singing for which they are noted. Danise is vocally ideal as Di Luna, while the singing and characterization of Mme. Bourskaya as Azucena are outstanding.

### North Shore Residents Named for Commission

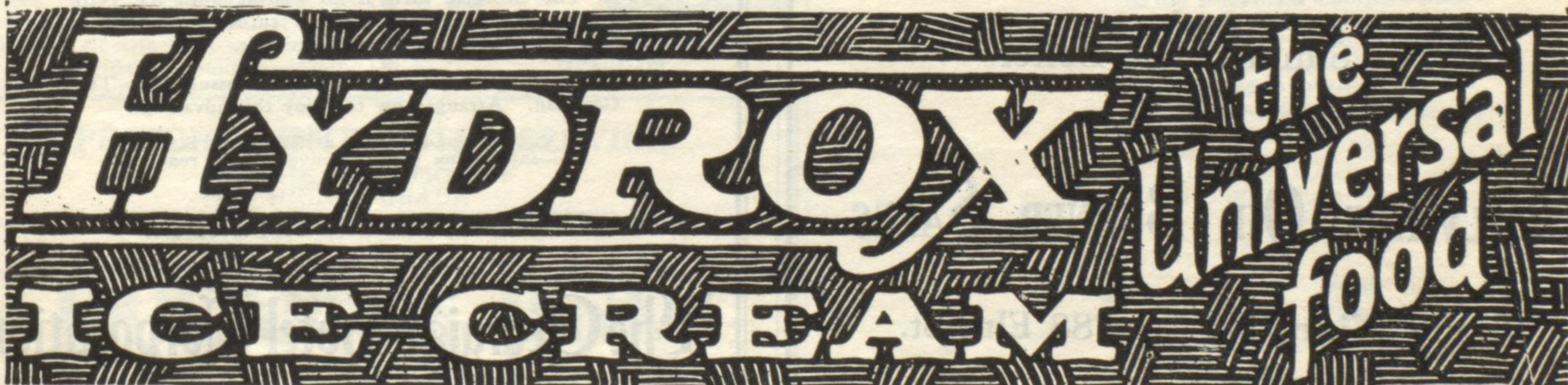
