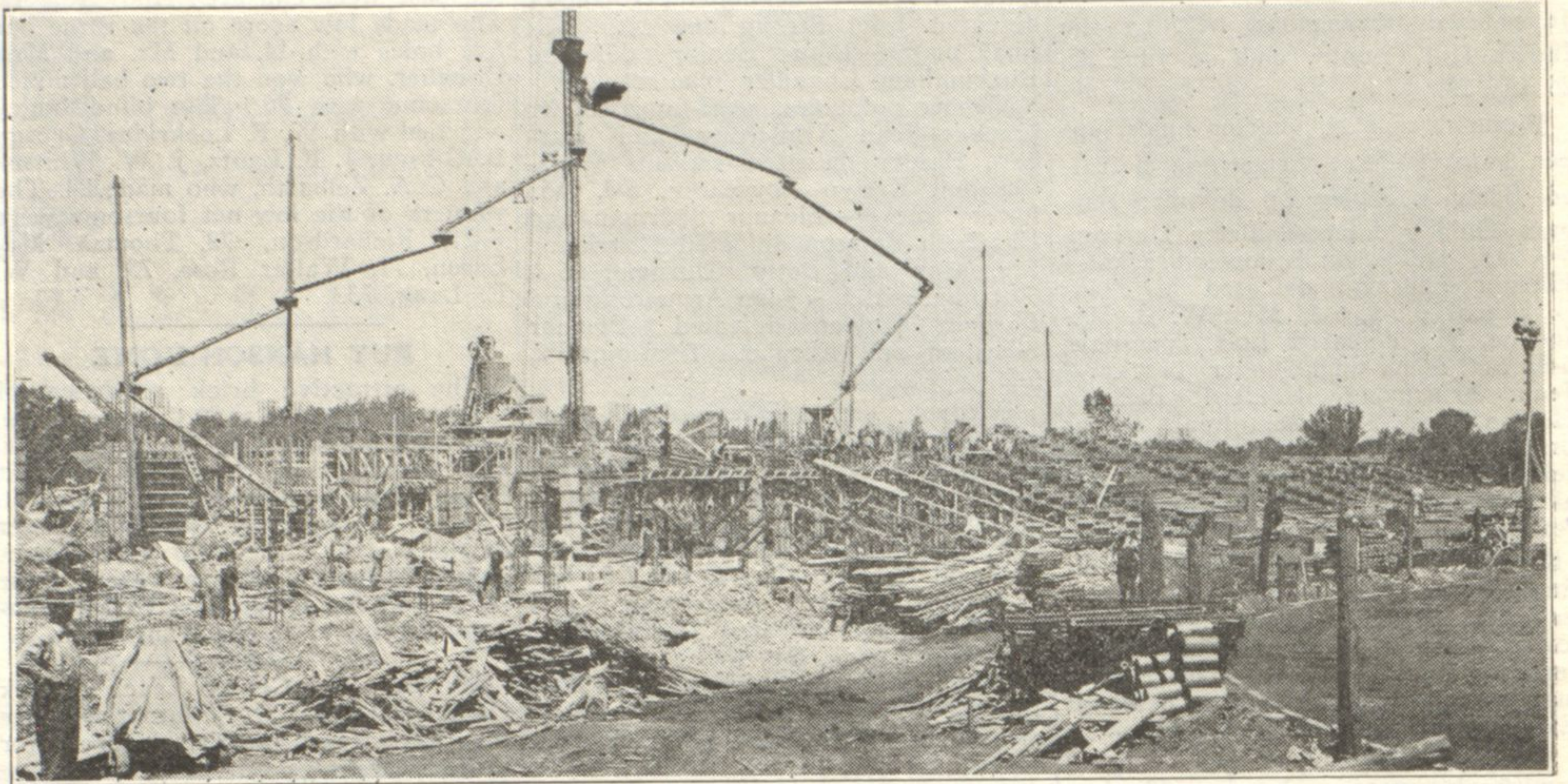

Day after day without ceasing crews of laborers are erecting the forms and pouring the concrete which is expected to take shape by the end of the summer in Northwestern's million-dollar football bowl. A recent strike of structural iron workers caused a delay, and contractors and their men are now bending every effort to make up for lost time so that the work will be far enough along to permit the playing here of the university's first home game next fall. One of the two masts from which the fluid concrete is distributed to the ever rising forms is shown here, as well as one of the batteries of floodlights which illumine the work at night.

Stage Pageant in Chicago for Visiting Elks

What is said to be the world's greatest outdoor production and fireworks spectacle will be seen in Chicago at the new Lincoln Park arena at Sheridan road and Waveland avenue on July 12. The arena is being built with permission of the Lincoln Park commission especially for the production.

It is "The Paean of 1776," held in commemoration of the One Hundred and Fiftieth Anniversary of American Independence. The spectacle is being held particularly for the thousands of visiting Elks who will be in convention at that time.

Opening with a collection of world famous circus acts, will be the noted "Riding Hobsons"—consisting of mother, father and two sons. Joe Miller, one-time equestrienne manager of the largest circuses in the world, is another of the principals.

Following the circus comes the tableaux of the patriotic spectacle of "1776." Thundering, roaring battle scenes with a thousand troops in action will depict the famous battle of Trenton. The pageant start in histor-

ical sequence with the great Boston Tea Party, and Paul Revere's mad dash to Lexington.

Breaking into the excitement of the thrilling stage-work, will be a minute of peacefulness when the Colonial Minuet ballet dances. All the quaintness and the loveliness of the revolutionary days, and the graceful ladies of that time will characterize the ballet—which consists of 50 dancers.

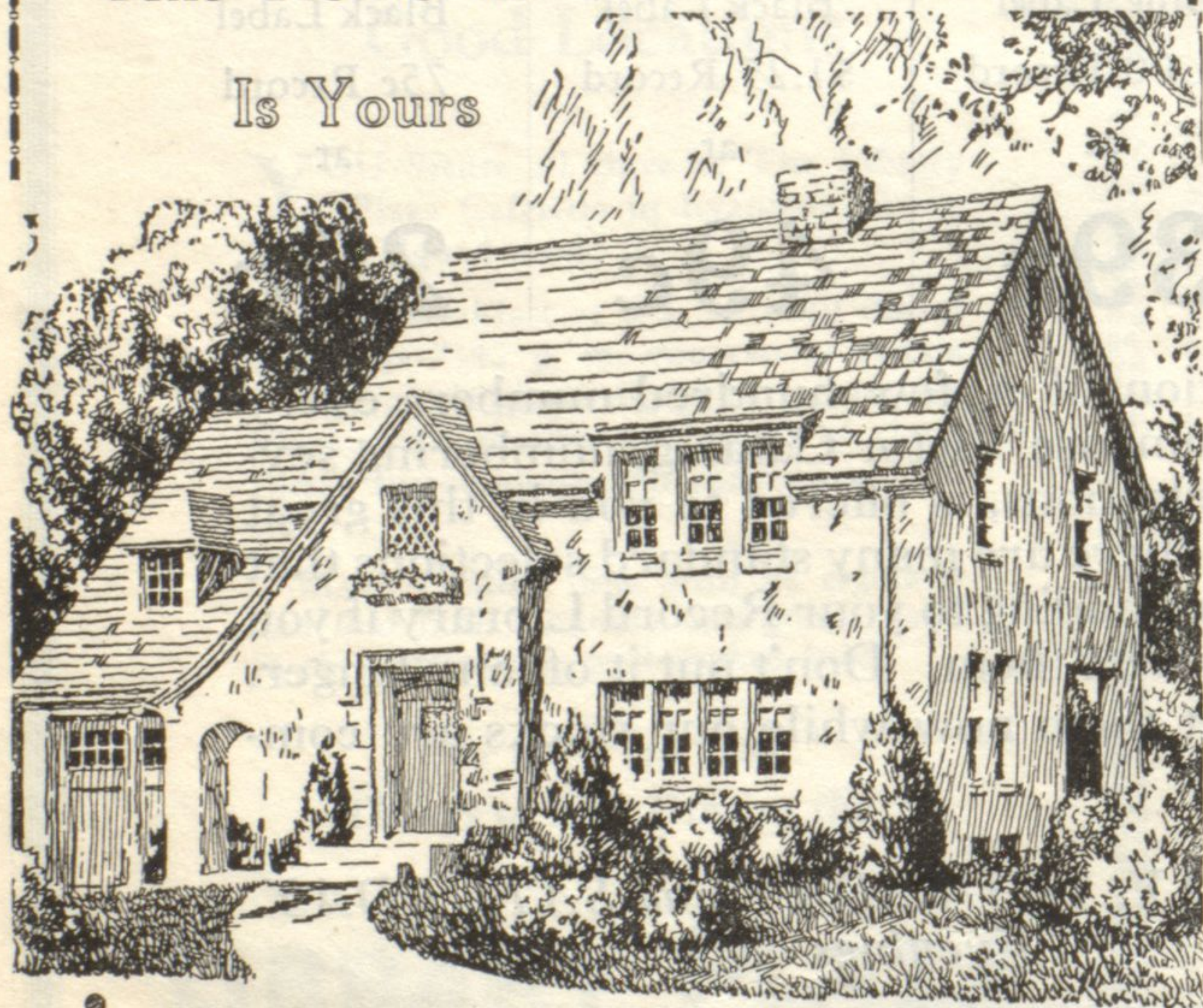
Betsy Ross and the first flag will be another of the tableaux; Cornwallis surrendering to Washington, another.
