He was soloist at the Salzburg Festival in 1923. A brilliant interpreter of the most modern music, he is, at the same time an exponent of the classics in a manner that has won hearty praise from the critics here and abroad. He will inaugurate the series of musicales to be given at Skokie Country club with a program next Sunday, July 18.




