Illinois Has Smallest Number of Diphtheria Deaths Ever Recorded Last Year

Mortality from diphtheria in Illinois last year, the lowest ever recorded, was heaviest in Massac, Perry, Pulacki and Kendall counties where the deaths from this cause per 100,000 population were 22, 21, 20 and 19 respectively compared with 5.8 for the state at large, according to a statement issued today by Dr. Isaac D.
