Babies Competing for Honors at State Fair

With 825 children scheduled for examination during the week and a galaxy of professional talent employed to make the numerous scientific tests which each youngster must undergo, the eleventh annual State Fair Better Babies conference opened this morning under most favorable circumstances, according to Dr. Isaac D. Rawlings, state health director. Ambitious that theirs shall be the healthiest, finest babies on earth and not averse to accepting the attractive awards offered, the youthful mothers take seriously the advice given in consultation by expert pediatric physicians. With central Illinois, from which the conference has always drawn more than 90 per cent of its patrons, boasting of a lower infant mortality rate than obtains anywhere else in the state and with families in this section having received during the past ten years \$5,000, plus half a score of gold watches and as many silver loving cups given for superior physical excellence it appears that the dual purpose of the mothers is a practical realization.

"Infant mortality in central Illinois is lower than that in either the northern or southern sections of the state," said Dr. Rawlings. "It is reasonable to believe that the scientific medical knowledge disseminated through the baby conference has favorably influenced that condition. For this reason the children registered for examination are especially fortunate.

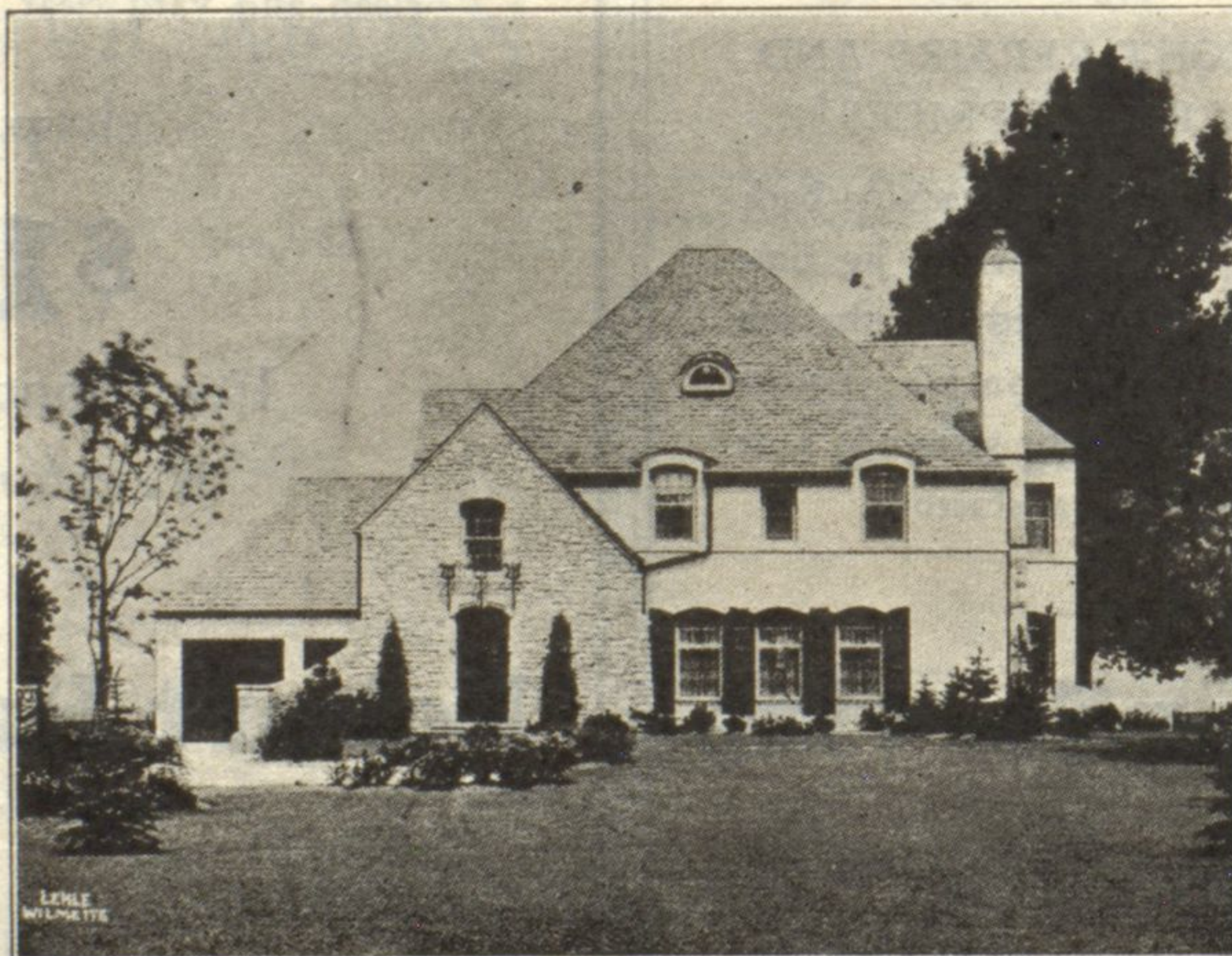
