position would be waiting for him when he came back. He advised him to take it as public duty and an important public service.

"I'll be at the job two and a half years. That's all, no more," said Mr. Clabaugh to me.

In writing this article I am not representing Mr. Clabaugh as a friend. Though I saw him often during the war, almost every day for many months, it was all business. Until I shook his hand the other night, I had not spoken to him or seen him since late in 1918, nearly eight years ago, just after the World war closed and our paths ceased to cross.

Wants Aid of Business

I am representing the Illinois Chamber of Commerce and the people of Illinois. I have come into this picture now to serve a purpose. Hinton G. Clabaugh has a request to ask of the people of Illinois. He wants organized business men to take place in the firing line for the enforcement of law.

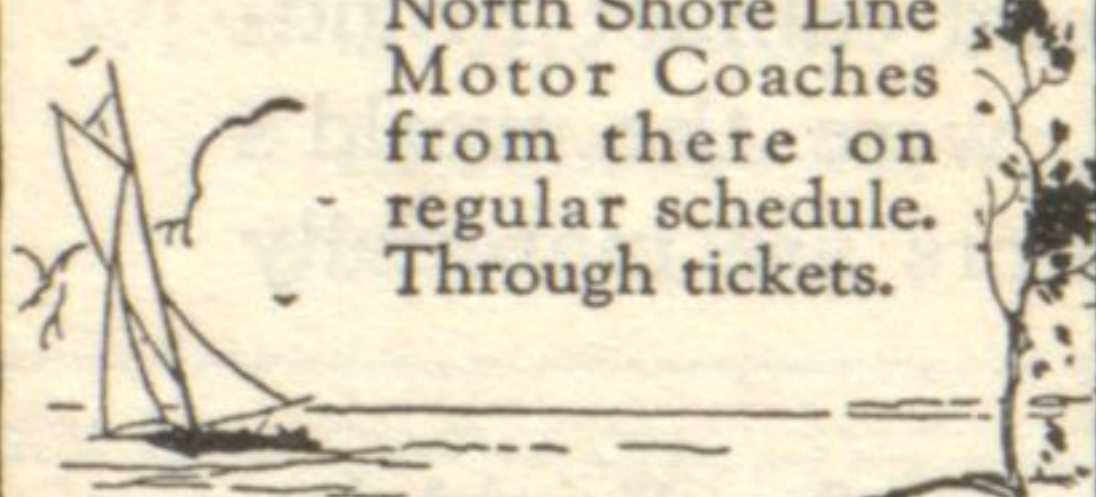

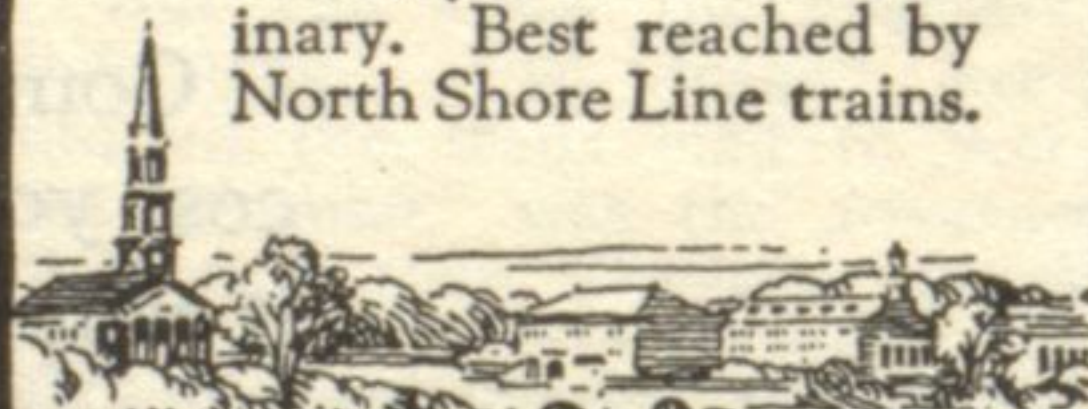
