"The Standard 'Hydro' press has two compartments, each filled with a definite amount of water which supports a flexible cover. Hence, immediately the cover is depressed by the sole of a shoe under pressure, the water is displaced and moulds the cover into the shape of the sole. The water, being incompressible, offers an immediate resistance, as hard as iron, thus giving a perfectly even pressure on the sole and waist of the shoe."


