Motor Club Tells All About How to Start Motor Cars

"Most car owners seem to understand that starting a modern gasoline engine is a matter of applying the energy of a storage battery to an electric motor and thence to the flywheel of the engine in the form of mechanical energy through some suitable sprocket or gear drive," says a bulletin issued by the mechanical first aid department of the Chicago Motor club. "The chief difficulty seems to be in keeping these elements in such condition that they will be on the job at all times and to know enough about the electrical system of the car to keep the engine going after it has been started.

"Some of the units involved in this process are so 'simple' that they are a constant source of trouble to owners who place too much reliance upon good luck. There isn't much about an electric starter-motor that differs from the motor that runs the household fan or the ice machine, except that it is constructed with a view to being dust-proof and, in some instances, is combined with the generator through the movement of brushes during the cranking process.

"Between the battery and the starter-motor engineers try to provide an easy path for current flow. This explains why one finds a heavy cable for this connection instead of the ordinary wiring size found around the distributor, lighting switch and coil."

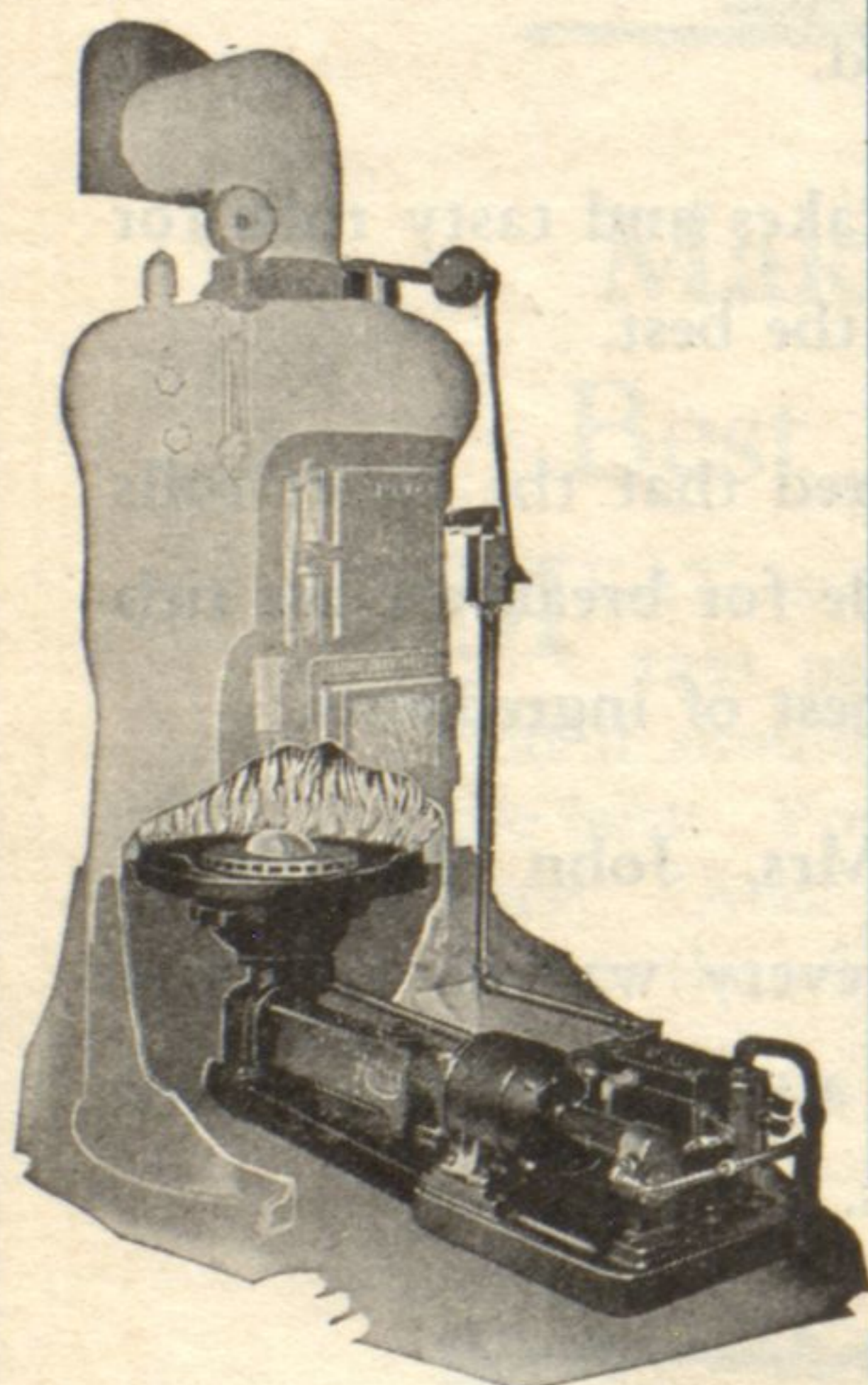

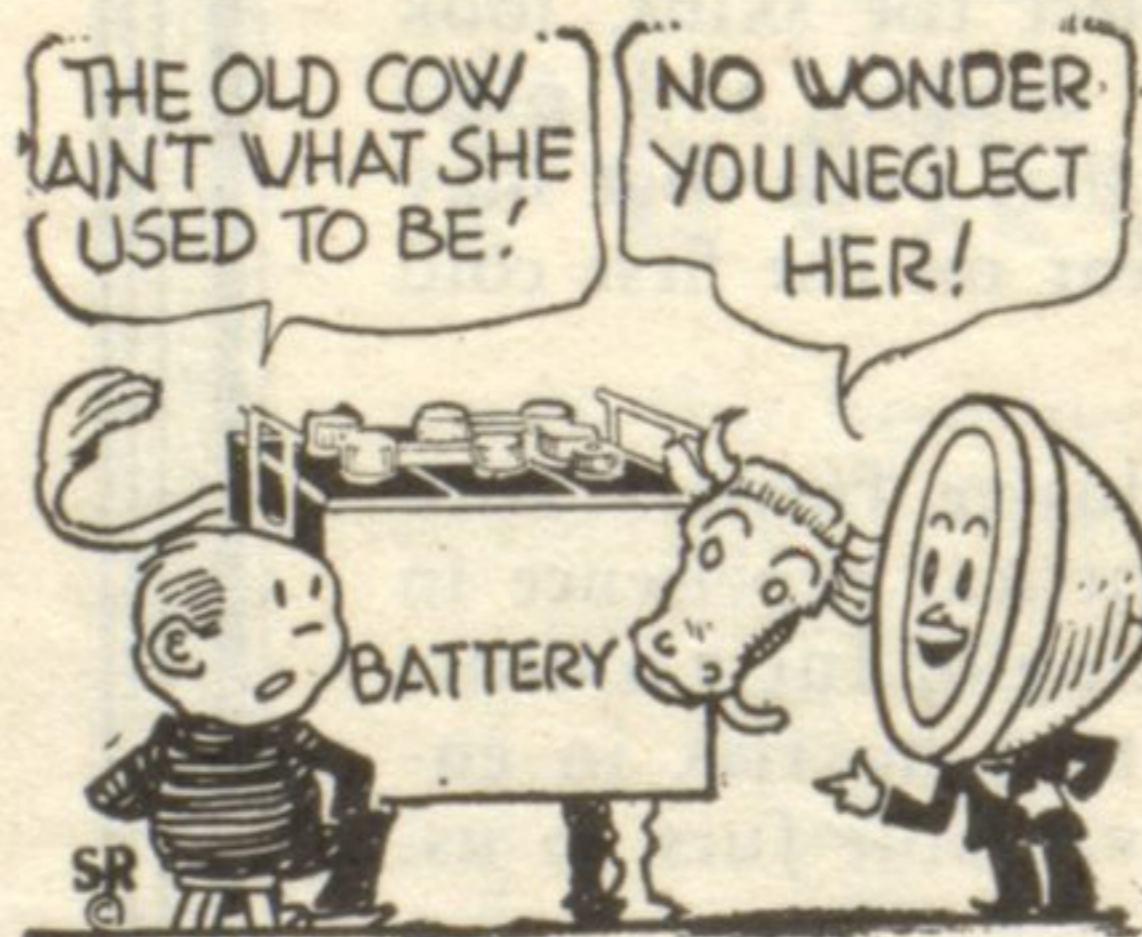
