Winnetka Section Men Win Garden Contest Award

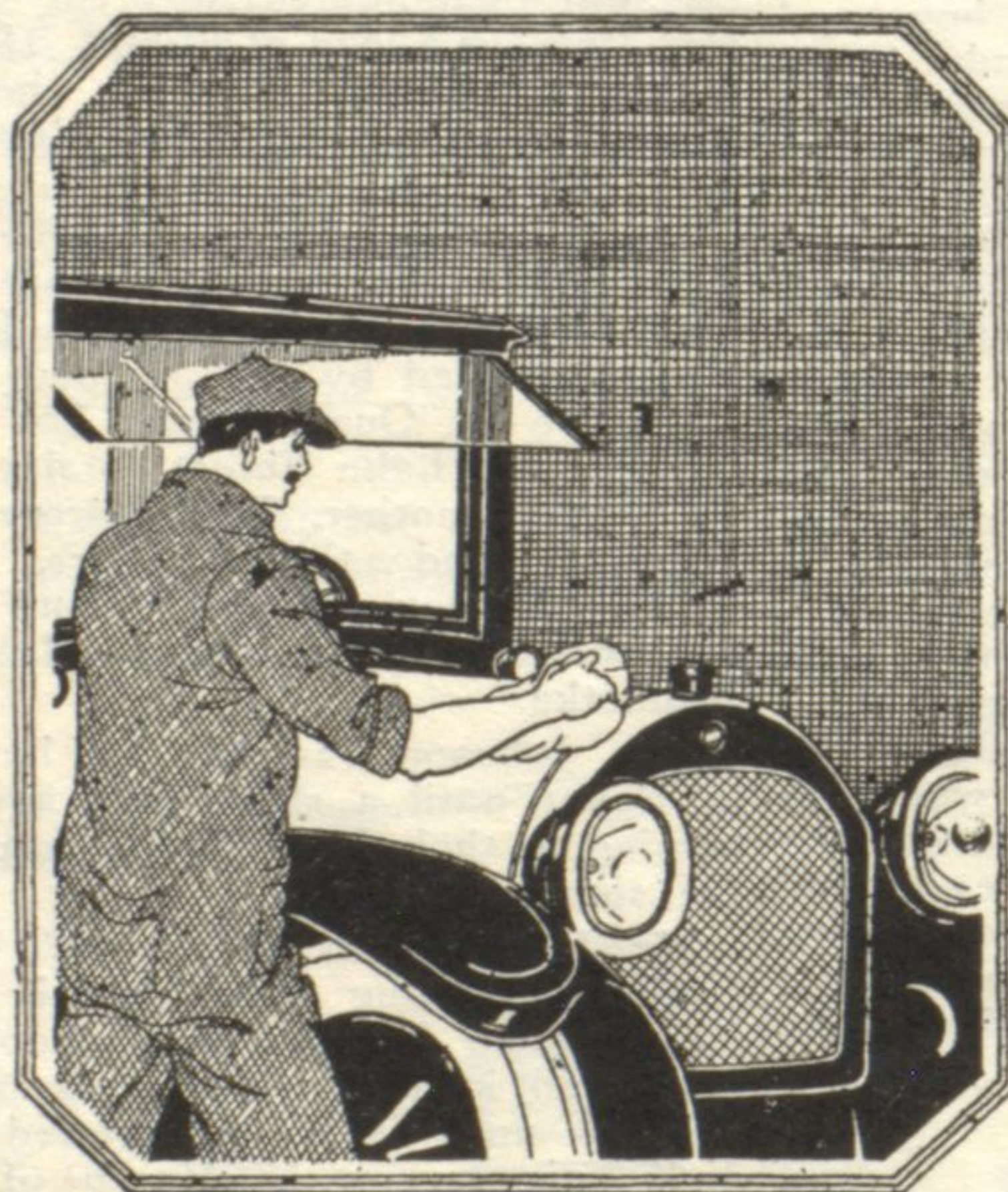
"Eleven section crews entered the contest and developed garden plots, all of which received high praise from the judges.
