Under the new health ordinance, adopted recently, a board of health is created, and it is specified that the health commissioner devote his full time to the work, which will include educational hygiene and more complete examination of school children. A number of physicians have applied for the position of health commissioner. Dr. C. O. Schneider, present health commissioner, did not put in an application as he felt unwilling to give up his personal practice.

**Plan Powerful Beacon
for Emergency Signal**

Winnetka village officials are planning to install a new police signal to notify patrolmen to call the station when emergency calls are received at night. This will be a 900 candle-power searchlight of the General Electric type, developed for the purpose of an air beacon and used by the air mail service. The new light is to be installed on top of the Iredale warehouse on Center street in the near future. It will be controlled from the police station. The present signal lights for patrolmen are ordinary red lights located on the Village hall, the New Trier High school tower and the municipal water tower on the lake front. These are not always visible to the patrolmen. The new light is very powerful and it is hoped that the experiment will prove successful so that it may replace the three red lights.
