"Matter" was the subject of the Lesson-Sermon in all Churches of Christ, Scientist, Sunday, September 19.

The Golden Text was from Psalms 56:4, "In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me."

Among the citations which comprised the Lesson-Sermon was the following from the Bible: "Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned Love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever. For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: But the word of the Lord endureth for ever" (I Peter 1:22-25).

The Lesson-Sermon also included the following passage from the Christian Science textbook, "Science and

Health with Key to the Scriptures," by Mary Baker Eddy: "The suppositional warfare between truth and error is only the mental conflict between the evidence of the spiritual senses and the testimony of the material senses, and this warfare between the Spirit and flesh will settle all questions through faith in and the understanding of divine Love" (p. 288).
