Would Stop Building of Clubs In "No Man's Land"

Plans for preventing the erection of the two clubhouses and the theater and store buildings now proposed for "No Man's Land," between Kenilworth and Wilmette, were discussed at a meeting of representatives of both communities held at the Kenilworth community house last Sunday evening. The meeting was called by James C. Murray, president of the Kenilworth board, and more than one hundred persons attended. Trustee Clarence E. Drayer and Village Attorney Charles H. Jackson of Wilmette represented the Village board. The clubs which are planning to erect buildings on the grounds are the Vista del Lago and the Breakers. A syndicate of north shore men have already started construction on a theater and block of stores. Attorney Charles H. Jackson of Wilmette and Attorney Andrew Jackson of Kenilworth were instructed to investigate the possibility of stopping the construction of these buildings by law.
