Walter Spry of Evanston, well known Chicago pianist and teacher, is now conducting classes at the Winnetka branch of the Columbia School of

Music. Mr. Spry teaches the more advanced pupils, and has many talented students along the north shore.

A famous educator in America in musical work, Mr. Spry has concertized in all parts of the United States. His concert work has taken him to New York, Philadelphia, Boston, St. Louis, Los Angeles and many southern universities. In Alabama, Mr. Spry has conducted for two years a master course, for the advanced students, at the University of Alabama at Montevallo, Ala.

Mr. Spry's European study was pursued under the most famous artists and masters. In Vienna he was instructed personally by Prof. Theodor Leschetizky. He has studied and become well known in many other European cities.

Mr. Spry is now preparing a series of ten piano recitals to be given in Chicago this winter season. These recitals will include the principal works of the great composers of all ages, both past and contemporary. He is well equipped for this work for he has studied with so many masters in music and has given recitals in many cities in this country.

His technical method is founded on natural laws, and is the result of close observation of such artists as Bauer, Carreno, Hofmann and Godowsky, all of whom Mr. Spry has known many years personally, it is stated.

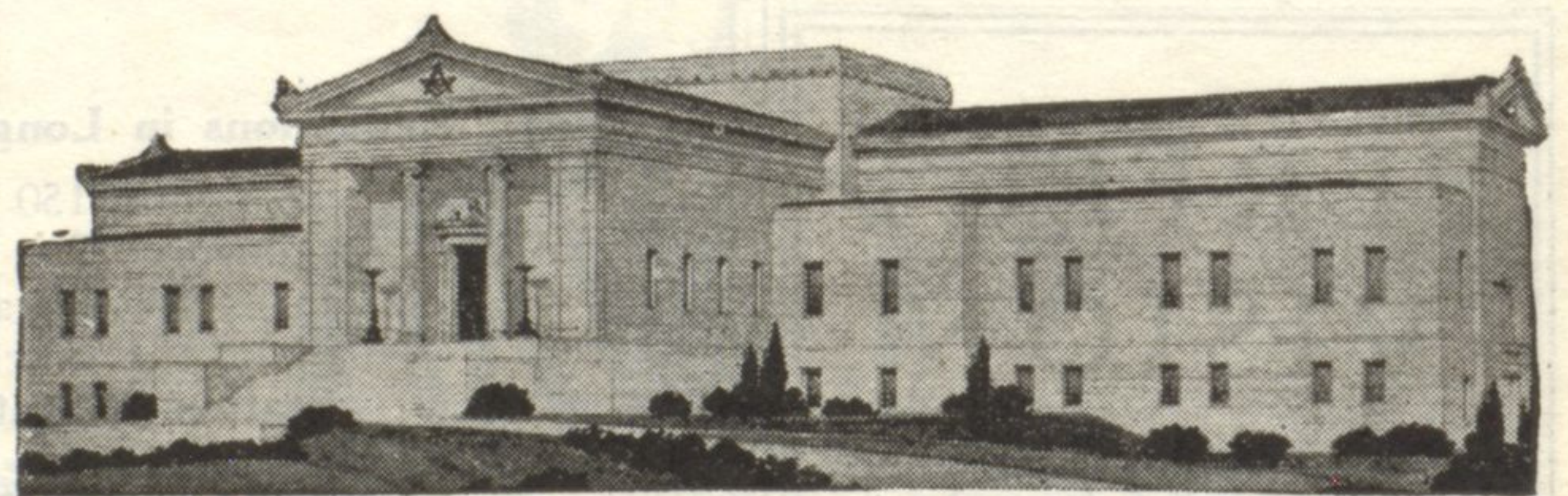
CHRISTIAN SCIENCE SERVICE
