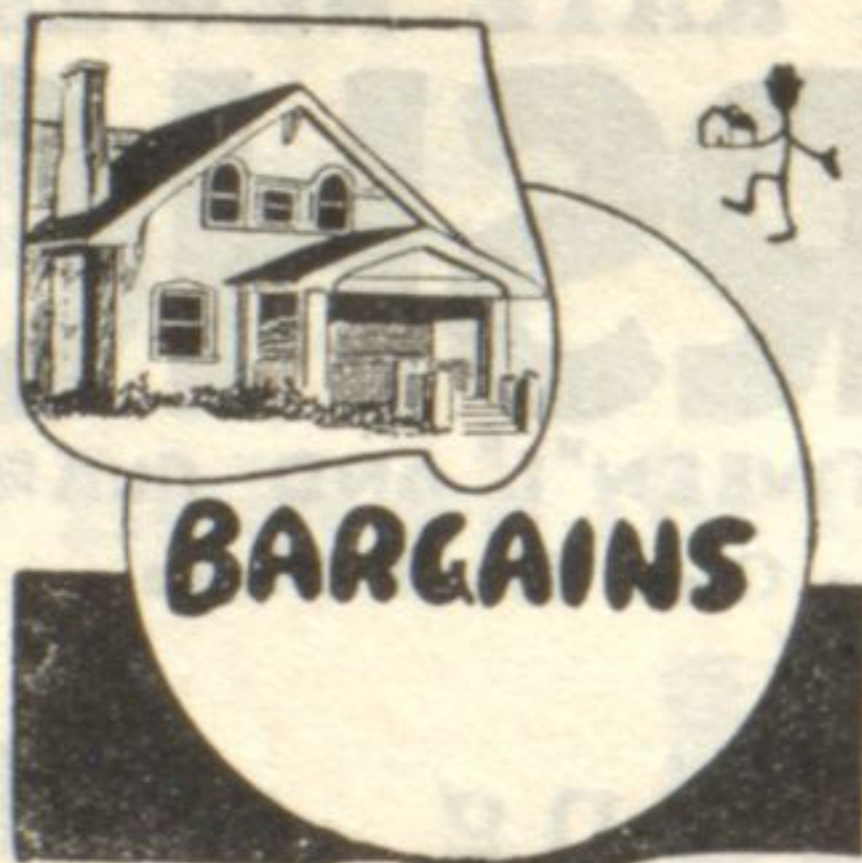

### Open Model Homes for Inspection by Public

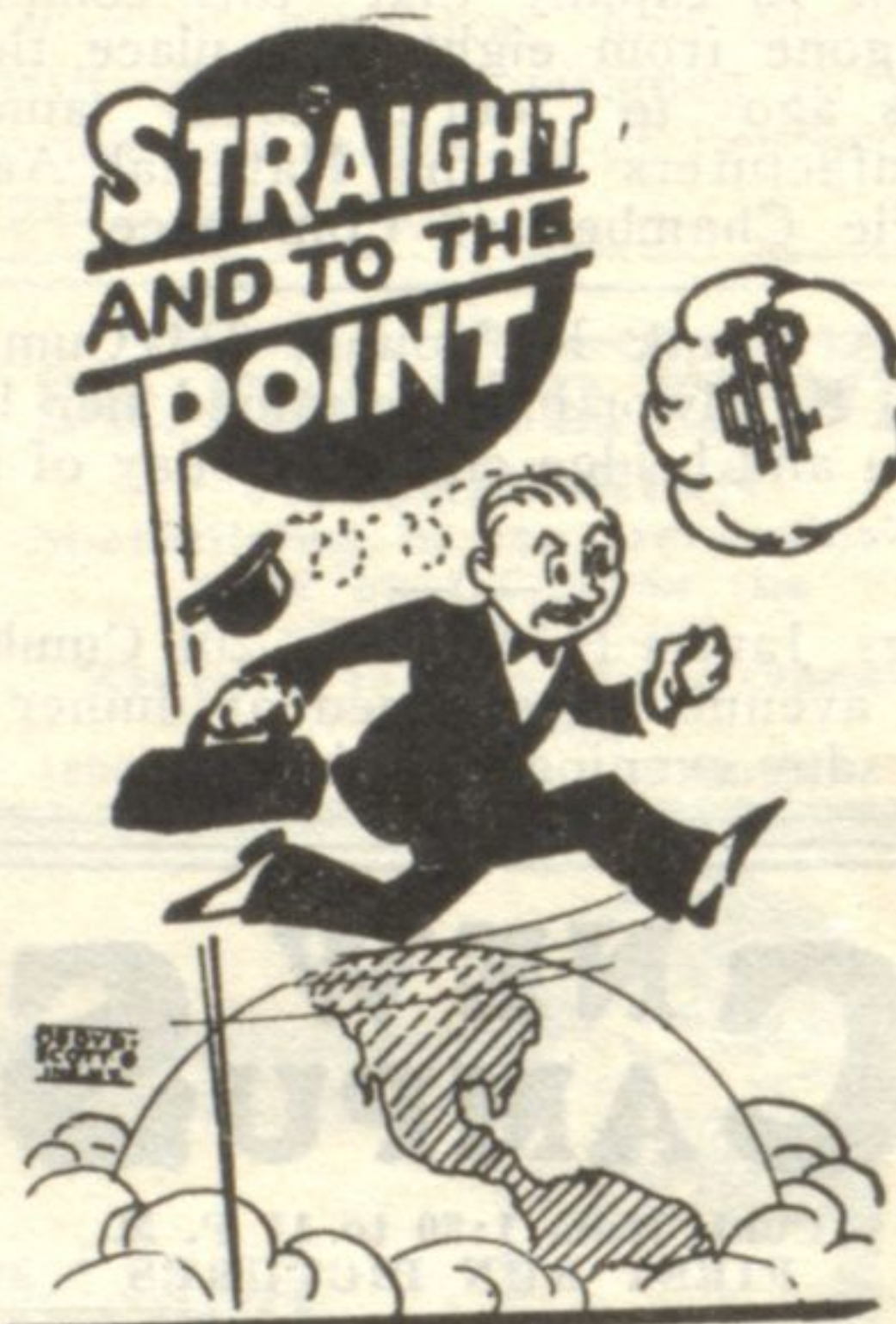
