**Kenilworth Boy Scouts Hold Record for Hikes**

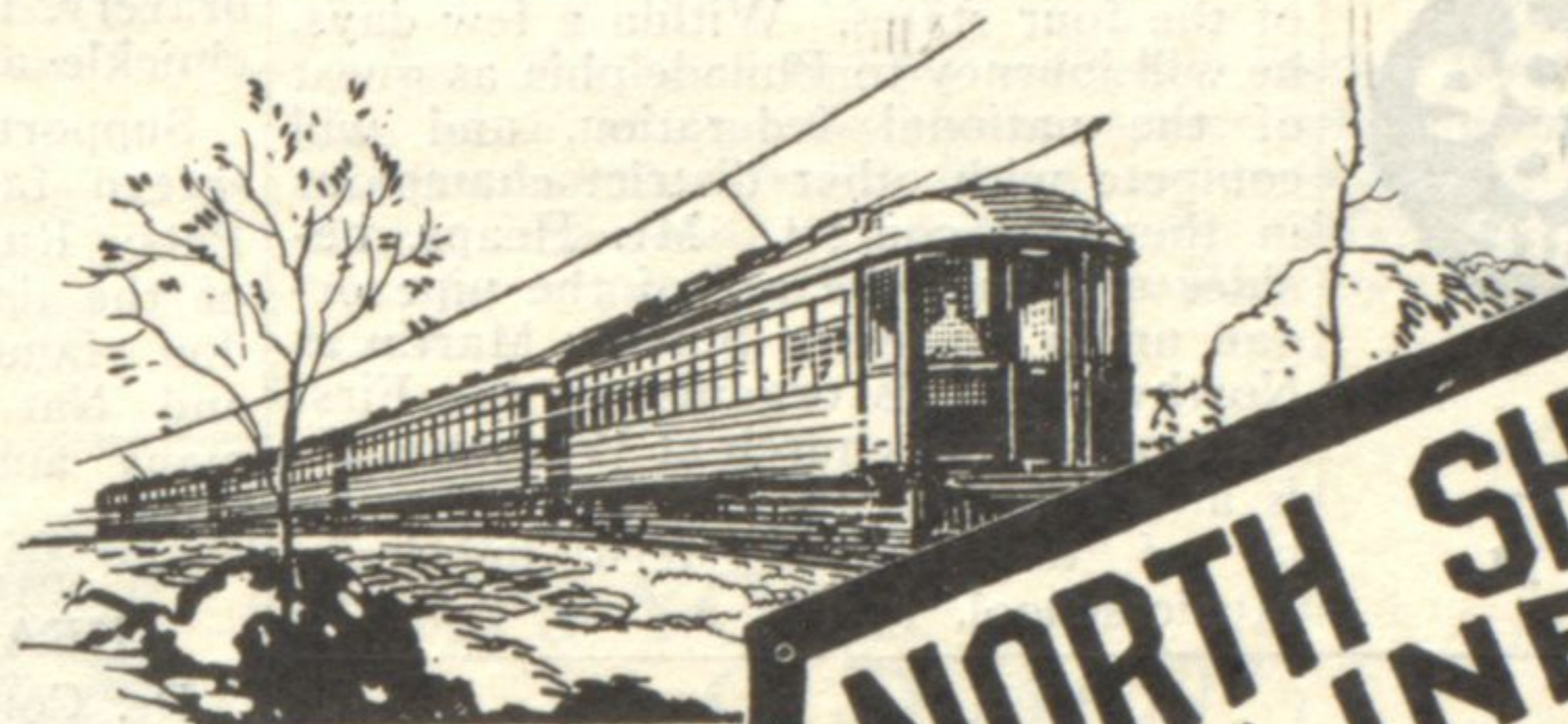
Seven week-end hikes in seven weeks and nineteen scouts to a hike. That's a record and it'll have to be "hats off" to the Kenilworth Scouts, for any
