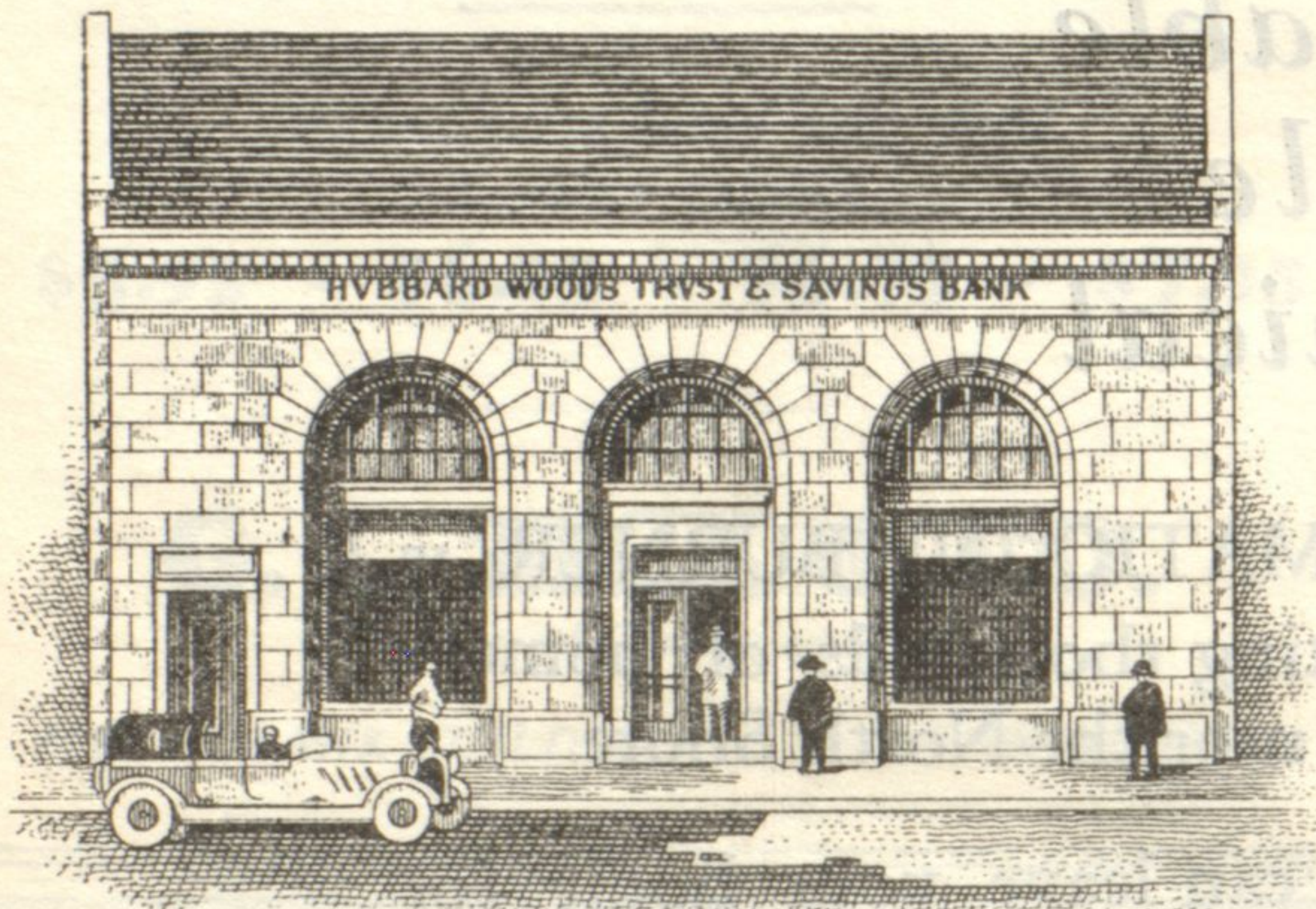

The goals were made by Peggy Waidner, 2, Mrs. Hallett Thorne, 1, Miss Margaret DeLay, 1, and Mrs. Thomas McLaren, 1. The goal made by the opposing team was shot by Mrs. Austin Pardue, formerly Dorothy Kotz, member of last year's Winnetka team. Mrs. Pardue has moved from Winnetka since her marriage, and affiliated herself with the North Side team.

The next encounter the Winnetka team had, was the North Shore Country Day school, on Wednesday afternoon, November 3, and the next practice for the All-Chicago team, will take place Saturday, November 6, at Washington Park. The All-Chicago team has not been announced, and will not be for a time.

The Madison Yellow-Jackets have wired an invitation to the All-Chicago team to send a team up to Madison this week-end, and a game will be played there Sunday morning, November 7.
