

### Wildcats Sharpen Claws to Capture Victory Saturday

Northwestern's fast stepping football team will attempt to annex its third conference victory Saturday in the game with Purdue at Dyche stadium.

Coach Thistlethwaite's Wildcats are already casting longing eyes towards the conference championship and they consider the coming engagement with the Boilermakers as one of the biggest obstacles in their path.

Saturday's game will see one of the two contenders put out of the race for conference honors. Purdue has not been defeated so far this season, and is determined to emerge victorious in the homecoming tilt. The Wildcats are equally set on taking the measure of the victors; so to all appearances the game should be a thriller.

#### Expect Capacity Crowd

A capacity crowd is expected to gather in Northwestern's new stadium for the game. Since all the seats for the Chicago game have already been sold, the Purdue game will be the only chance for those without Chicago tickets to see the Purple in action this year.

Northwestern will present its strongest front against Purdue. Coach Thistlethwaite plans to take no chances by starting his second string lineup. The visitors have a flock of good players headed by the speedy Wilcox who will have to be watched carefully all afternoon. The Boilermakers trounced Chicago two weeks ago.

Northwestern's victory over Indiana last Saturday was the second conference win of the season and has stirred the team to added endeavor to keep its slate clean. Three more games are to be played this season, and all will require considerable effort to win.

Following Purdue, Chicago will come out to Evanston for the dedication game November 13. It will be the first time that the Maroons have come to the north side for a game in a number of years.

In the Indiana game the Wildcats demonstrated that they still hold the upper hand on the wet field. Last year the Purple licked Michigan under worse conditions than prevailed Saturday.

#### Worthy of Dry Gridiron

Despite the wet field and downpour, both teams displayed flashes of football that would have done justice to a dry gridiron. "Tiny" Lewis started the day's activities when he caught Indiana's kick off and raced sixty-five yards for a touchdown. A minute later Fisher fell on a fumble behind the Hoosiers' goal line, giving Northwestern a 14-point lead.

With this advantage the Wildcats coasted along content to protect the margin they had run up and wait for more breaks. The third Purple score came in the third quarter when Holmer bucked and tore his way through the center of Indiana's line for a touchdown. He ran fifty yards on the play.

Much of the same lineup as faced Notre Dame two weeks ago will be used by Coach Thistlethwaite Saturday. Baker will be at quarterback with Gustafson and Levison at the halfback posts. Lewis will be at fullback. The line will include Johnson and R. Schuler, tackles; Dart and Siebenmann, guards; Rosie, center, and Fisher and Bovik, ends.
