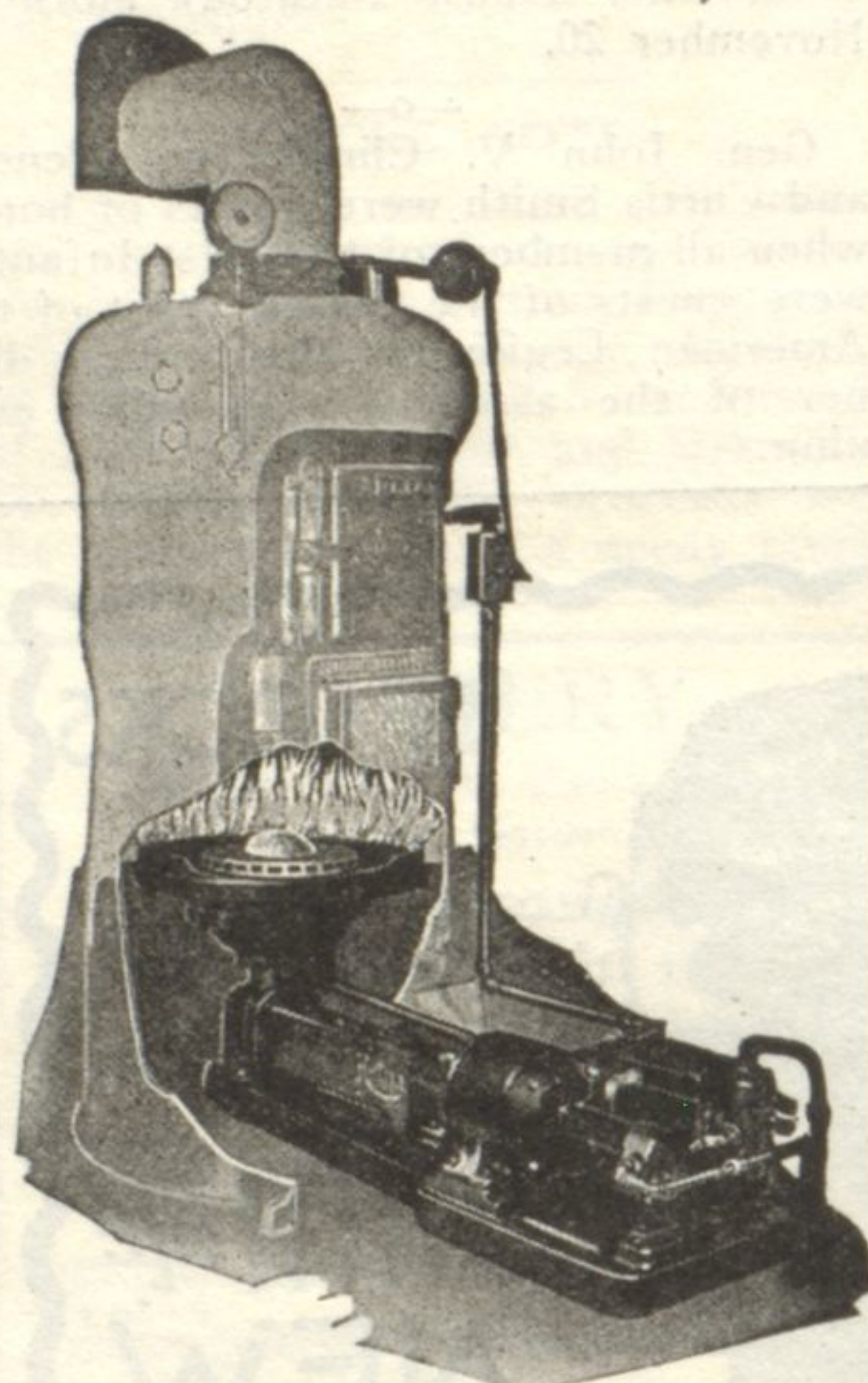

**MUSICAL ASSEMBLIES
STARTED AT SKOKIE**

James Fentress Presents Negro Spirituals; Other Concerts Follow Through Year

The first of a series of special assemblies, held in connection with a music appreciation course, at the Skokie school, was given Tuesday morning, November 9, when James Fentress presented a half-hour recital of negro spirituals and secular folk songs. Mr. Fentress sang to his own accompaniment on a guitar and prefaced each number by a brief description of the setting in which it was originated. He has a first hand acquaintance with the original conditions under which these songs were conceived and consequently his presentations were authentic. His program was enthusiastically received by the student body and a warm invitation has been extended for him to return whenever it is convenient for him to do so.

Hear European Songs

The second concert, which will be devoted to European folk songs, will be given November 22, and other numbers of the series will occur thereafter at intervals of two weeks. In February the simpler forms of piano composition will be treated. The first two concerts will be devoted chiefly to dance forms, while later ones will introduce some of the principal orchestral solo instruments. One of these will be devoted entirely to the flute and clarinet; another to the violin, viola and cello; and a third to the more complex forms of piano composition. The last five numbers will present movements from sonatas and symphonies. Two pianos will be used in the presentation of one of these and a Debussy recital will provide study of modern music.

The climax to the series comes in the form of two concerts by an artist string quartet. These concerts will also be given at each of the four Winnetka schools and the movements played presented in other programs and music classes.

Approach Symphony Study

The various forms in the series include everything up to a study of symphony. It has been suggested that all who can, and especially those enrolled in the music appreciation courses, avail themselves of the opportunity to complete the study by attending the little symphony concerts which are being given at the New Trier high school. Symphony, it is said, is a type of music that cannot be adequately presented mechanically. To fully appreciate it one must hear the actual playing. The three remaining concerts of the series will be given on Monday afternoons, November 15, January 10, and February 7.

Appreciation of the splendid co-operation given by the people of Winnetka in making the music appreciation course possible has been expressed by the school authorities. Without this aid the course would have been absolutely impossible.
