

### Request Engineers to Study Widening of Highway North

At the meeting of the Village council Tuesday evening, at which there was not a quorum present, a number of matters were discussed but upon which no formal action was taken.

The council asked Village Engineer F. A. Windes to make a study of the matter of widening and repaving Center street from Elm street to Tower road, as a part of the through traffic highway. This project, it is said, will also probably include changes at Chestnut and Spruce streets, so that Chestnut will connect directly with Center street, and also possibly the widening and repaving of Chestnut street.

The work of laying concrete in Center street from Winnetka avenue to Oak street was finished this week, and sidewalks are now being relaid and adjusted. As soon as some macadam connections are put in, the road will be ready for traffic, which it is anticipated will be about December 11.
