"On passenger vehicles it is necessary for the applicant to give his name, street and city address, the make of car, color and style of body, kind of power, date of purchase, serial and motor numbers, with the bore of the cylinders and the amount of horse license number.

"The technical information concerning the stroke and bore of the motor and the horse power can be obtained at our office from reference books which the association keeps on hand. All other information must be given by the owner of the car.

"Every driver in Evanston and the other north shore communities is welcome to come here for this free service."
