### Village Issues Monthly Report on Milk Analysis

The Village ordinance regulating milk products provides that milk delivered in Winnetka must be pasteurized and must not show a bacterial count higher than 100,000 per cubic centimeter. It also provides that butterfat shall not be less than 3 per cent.

Samples of milk taken on November 16 showed the following results:
