**W. G. Hettich Wins  
Gold Medal Award  
for New Invention**

Word has been received that the  
gold medal of the Radiological society  
of North America, was awarded to  
William G. Hettich, 1011 Central ave-  
nue, Wilmette, at the annual meeting  
of the society held in Milwaukee last  
week.

Mr. Hettich received the medal for  
his invention of a safety feature on the  
high voltage transformer used in the  
production of X-Rays. On transfor-  
mers equipped with this safety device  
no dangerous shock can be received  
by the Roentgenologist or the patient,  
even though the transformer is being  
operated at as high a potential as  
200,000 volts.

It is noteworthy that only two other  
laymen have received this medal,  
Madam Curie of Paris, and W. D.  
Coolidge of the General Electric com-  
pany.

Mr. Hettich is president of the Stan-  
dard X-Ray company of Chicago.
