### Santa Claus Toy Shop of North Shore Country Day School Opens to Receive Gifts

Each year interest and enthusiasm in the work has increased, and today, every student in the school is spending all his free periods during the school day in the toy shop, which has been organized into various departments, each of which is in charge of a student head.

#### "New" Toys From Old

There is a shop for making brand new toys. Then there is a shop where old toys are being reconstructed into toys that are just as good as new ones. There is a paint shop where both the new and old toys are given the finishing bright touches.

There is a toy marine department, with dry dock "an' n'ever'thing," where old boats are given new keels, donkey engines or whatever the inspection marine board determines is needed.

New boats are being built and launched down the ways into Santa Claus harbor and there are machine shops for the overhauling and repairing of toy engines, cars and other mechanical toys.

#### Dolls Get New Frocks

Scores of dollies are on the waiting list for consultation as to their desire in the way of complete new wardrobes, which busy hands will make for them. Hundreds of books are being brought in which are to be turned over to the book department for renovating, repairing and even re-binding.
