**MISS HANSEN PLAYS**

And Her Playing Enthralls Patrons at Winnetka Music Club Artists-Recital Monday

Cecilia Hansen, violinist, played with an amazing amount of skill and sympathy, on Monday evening at New Trier high school, at the second of the artists recitals sponsored by the Winnetka Music club. One can hardly conceive of a woman violinist who could equal the heights of technique

and tonal quality reached by Miss Hansen, who is certainly a musician of uncommon gifts. Her tone is large and mellow, and, playing on the famous Stradivarius once owned by Wilhelmj, Miss Hansen left nothing to be desired.

Her first number was Vitali's "Ciaronna," which was very flowing and melodious. The second group began with Beethoven's "Rondino," exquisitely gentle under Miss Hansen's bow. "Melodie" by Gluck, which followed, was a lovely muted air; and the last, "Praeludium and Allegro" by Pugnani, was brilliant and vigorous. The entire second group had been arranged for the violin by Kreisler. In response to the enthusiastic audience, Miss Hansen was induced to play an encore, "Serenade" by Chaminade, which was intensely beautiful.

Tschaikowsky's "Concerto in D Major" which is probably one of the most difficult for violin, was taken with the utmost ease. Miss Hansen had so thoroughly mastered the technique of it that she could give the interpretation the attention it deserves.

The last group was composed of "Lotus Land," a liquid, floating bit of melody by Cyril Scott-Kreisler; "Danse," by Cyril Scott, which was

clean cut and saucy; Godowsky-Press' "Alt Wien," a thing of dainty charm which was very well liked; and Popper-Auer's "Spinnlied," gay and light, with a smooth motion.

Miss Hansen was very frugal with encores, but was finally persuaded to play her second on the evening's program, "Liebesfreud," by Kreisler, which she played with an altogether delightful manner.

**Cites Citizenship as Important Study for Women's Groups**

"The teaching of Citizenship through Clubs" was the subject of an interesting talk given by Mrs. M. H. Lieber of Winnetka before the students of the National Kindergarten and Elementary college Thursday afternoon.

"The big thing that we need today out in the world and in our own homes, is to know how to live together, and that is one thing that citizenship in clubs is doing. It is educating women to carry more ably the responsibilities that are placed upon them."

Mrs. Lieber told of some of the citizenship activities of the various clubs, and of the questions before the federal and state legislative bodies in which they are particularly interested. In conclusion she objected to the lack of interest on the part of many women in regard to laws which they think do not affect them personally. "If we are to lay the foundation for a future citizenship of this country and of the world as it should be laid we have got to take cognizance of these things."
