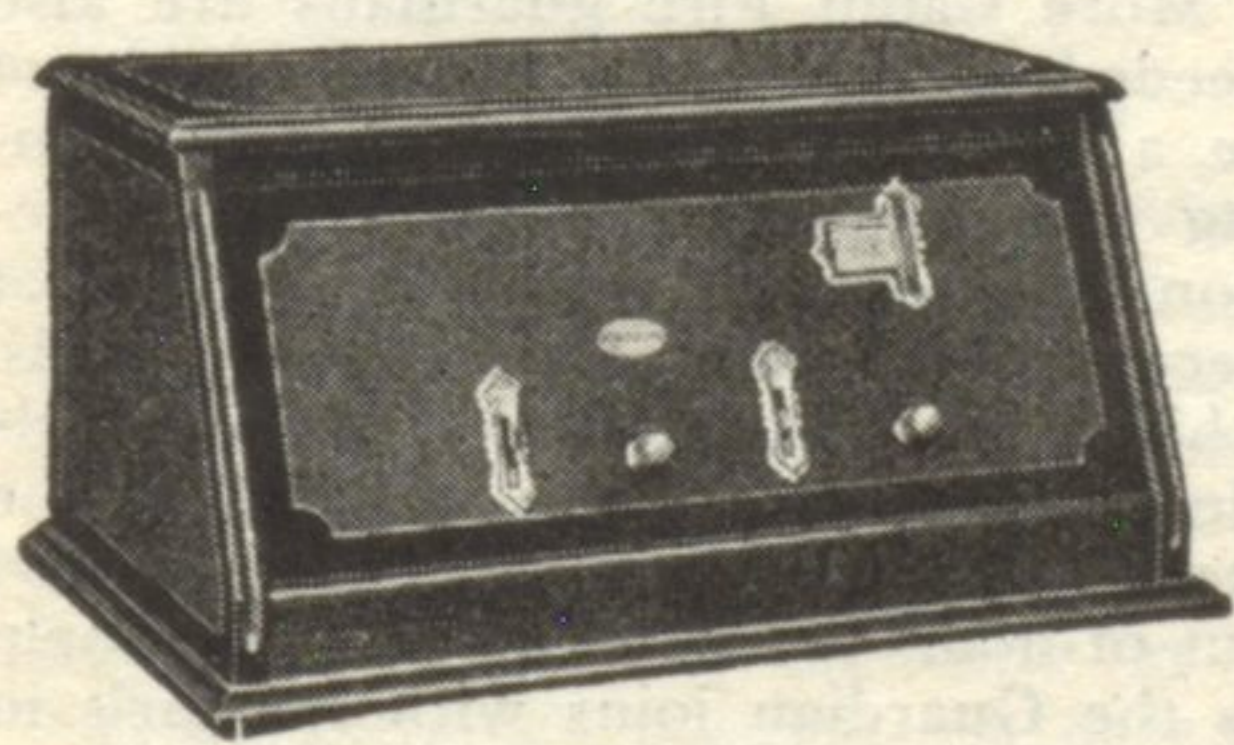
One of the best dance orchestras on the north shore is scheduled to play for the dance to be given by the club, Thursday, January 27, at the Winnetka Woman's club.

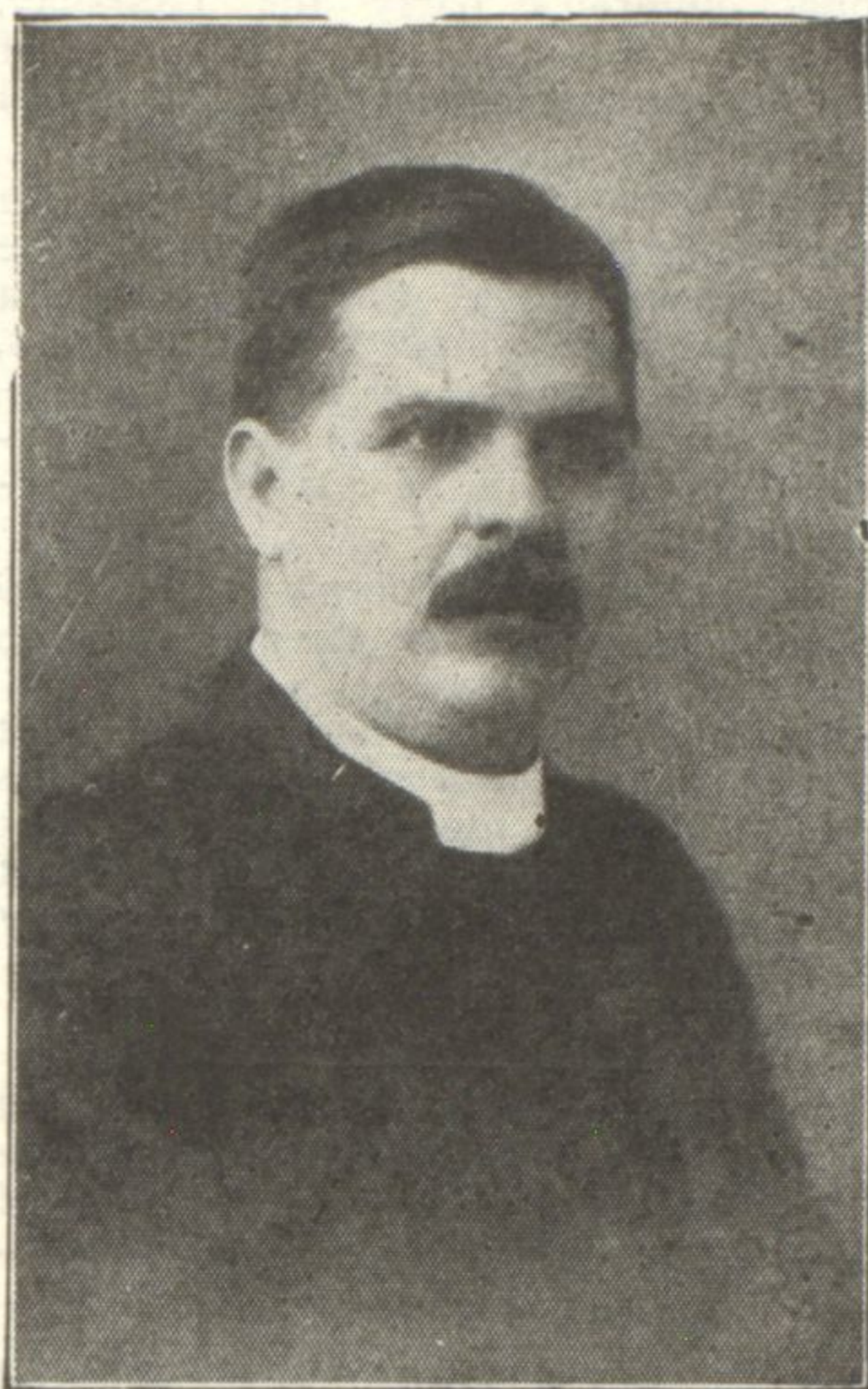
