Guardians are not necessarily former Camp Fire Girls. Ability to lead and to advise girls eleven to fifteen yars of age is the most important requirement. Love of out-of-door life and nature is a help as the Guardian joins with the girls in their play as well as their work. Some of the most remarkably good results with Winnetka girls are on record. What could be a greater or more worthy thing than to assist in guiding a young girl into perfect womanhood!
