C. of C. to Hear of Band Project for Our Village

"A Municipal Band for Winnetka," is to be the subject of a talk to be given by Alan A. Miller, of the Conn National School of Music, Chicago, before members of the Winnetka Chamber of Commerce at the regular December meeting, to be held Monday evening, December 13, at the Community House.

The speaker will outline the provisions of the new State Band Tax law, which enables municipalities under 500,000 population to appropriate two mills of every dollar of assessable property for band purposes. The bill embodying the law was signed by Governor Small on June 27, 1925, and provides for a popular election in each municipality desiring to take advantage of the statute.

The band tax law was defeated by a narrow margin at the last Village election.
